Old Business

- Family BBQ went well. About 40 in attendance.
- Flow testing of air pack from station 3 still hasn't been returned. Called today for followup.
- Issues with Quaker Brook stand pipe, might mean we have to redo it. Will have DEP evaluate before doing any work. Kyle Estes will follow up. Weeman road hydrant also needs some more work. It needs to be pumped down and then add 90 degree elbow. Work on Weeman Pond is scheduled for September 14 at 6:30. Woods Mill hydrant access has been cleared out.
- New tank truck in NY should be ready by the middle of September. After delivery will need to load hose and equipment and do training.
- Participation in July 4th parade was well coordinated to insure in town coverage of rolling equipment.
