The group talked about inviting Keizer businesses to participate in future meetings. Ron said he had mentioned REI because it is new to the city. The community garden is a meeting topic possibility. Carol said she would pursue this. Home Grown Theater is another potential topic.

Rhonda noted that the February board meeting would potentially be Feb. 5, but that Carol will be out of town. Ron said he would be gone as well. Rhonda proposed a joint Board/general membership meeting for Feb. 12, making it more of a social event, providing pizza and inviting everyone to help brain storm meeting topics for the coming year.
