### Call to Order

## Coordinator's report

Registration numbers – There are 13 students registered in Hay Lakes ECS. Of the 13 students, 3 of them will receive funding through PUF and will attend the Hay Lakes Play School program and 10 students will attend Hay lakes ECS.

Hiring and EA – Marie expressed her recommendation to have 3 Educational Assistants hired for the 2021/22 ECS school year. One EA will assist in the ECS classroom and 2 will assist at the play school. Salary offered will be \$21 per hour and Pam, Marie and Addie will carry out interviews to hire EAs.

EA vs Parent volunteers – Parent volunteers will not be a requirement for Hay Lakes ECS. We will plan to have adequate staffing in the classroom to provide consistency for the children. If Covid-19 protocols allow, we will make it an option for parents to attend ECS for their child's 'student of the day.'

Classroom supplies – The budget allotted for school supplies is \$4000 for the year. Addie will reuse much of the school supplies already available in the classroom. She will also investigate a new printer and will require \$500 + for toner and supplies for printing.

PUFF – Marie is requesting a \$1000 start up budget for the PUF students. She would like to purchase speech/language kits and wobbly chairs for the students. Items purchased for the PUF students will follow them through their education.

Parent meeting date – scheduled for Thursday August 26<sup>th</sup> at 7pm at the Rec center. Hay Lakes ECS will commence the week of September 13<sup>th</sup>. At the parent meeting, a vote will be held on the ECS schedule for either Mon/Wed and alternating Fridays or Tues/Thurs and alternating Fridays.

Budget for the 2021/22 school year is \$111,133 based on 20 registrations. ECS will also receive another \$56,000 through PUF in December.

## **Vice President's report**

The fundraiser sales will begin at the parent information meeting on August 26<sup>th</sup> and will close on October 14<sup>th</sup>.
