It is open Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. The Public Works site accepts electronics from households (televisions, computers, computer monitors, printers and other electronic equipment) and used motor oil, filters and bottles.

PLANTER'S ROW INAUGURAL SOCCER TOURNAMENT



At the Soccer Field on the Vineyard side of the neighborhood Saturday, September 19, 2015, 9am



(rain date Sunday September 20, 2015, 1:30pm)

- Ages 16+ coed with no ratio requirements.(i.e. any combination of male/female/age range, etc.)
 (we will arrange a separate tournament for under 16s, date and details to be confirmed)
- Planter's Row residents only one non-PR resident will be permitted per team.
- Water and fruit will be provided.
- Soccer cleats and shin guards are required.
- Number of players allowed per team and the amount of players playing at one time (i.e. 7v7, 6v6, 5v5, 4v4) will be determined by interest level.



- 4 Players will be the minimum per team.
- Players may form their own team, up to the maximum allowed by the tournament. Players who need to be put on a team can be put on a "free agent" list where a team can be formed from, or players can be accepted by another team who may be short of players.
- Games will consist of two 20-30 minute halves (depending on participation).
- Standard "small field" rules apply. Please email any questions in regards to the rules.
