Outreach will continue to collect NEW toys for the Apopka farm families through Hope CommUnity Center. This organization began in 1971 in Apopka with three nuns who had a vision to assist farm workers and the working poor. The Hope Center's mission is to be a service learning community dedicated to the empowerment of Central Florida's immigrant and working poor communities through education, advocacy and spiritual growth. They provide social services, tutoring, and college and career assistance for 500 families. Hope services the Apopka, Lake Brantley and Wekiva Springs areas. The donated NEW toys will be sold at their annual Christmas Toy Store for about 20% of the retail cost. This helps maintain dignity among the hardworking parents who can use this opportunity to provide for their children. Favorite items include board games, balls, craft sets and diapers.
