Every year the Shreveport Shriners Hospital, the very first Shriners hospital in the world, travels to Panama to seek children with spine, limb, and orthopaedic deformities to provide prosthetics and orthotics to assist them to live as normal as possible. Some of these Panamanian kids, with a parent, are brought to the Shreveport Shriners. They may need to stay in extended stay hotels anywhere from 5 weeks to 6 months until surgery and rehabilitation is complete. So how can you help? A large portion of Shriners expenses are provided through donations from the community, and Shriners thanks everyone for their support. For this project, we are requesting items often needed to help these Panamanian families have a comfortable stay. These items include: Detergent, diapers (Has to be Luvs or Pampers). Toothpaste (travel size), Deodorant (not spray). White socks (all sizes from small child to adult). Hairbrushes/combs, shampoo/conditioner. Batteries (all sizes). 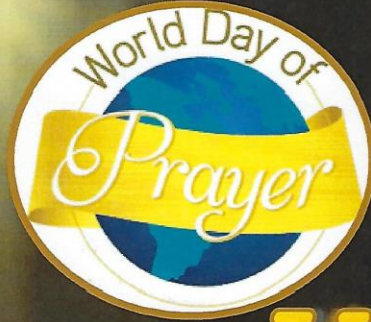

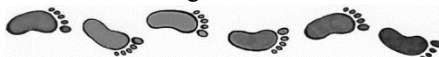
