# September 7 & 8, 2021(All classrooms- PRESCHOOL-GRADE 6)

Hours of operation: 8:00am-5:00pm

**AM drop:** 8am-9am (drop off is at the front door, main school entrance) **PM pick up:** 3:30pm-5pm (pick up is at the front door, main school entrance)

\*\*\*All children must be pre screened prior to drop off (information below)

## September 9, 2021 – Frist Day of School onwards

Hours of operation: 7:30am-6:00pm

**AM drop:** 7:30am-8:15am (drop off is at the front door, main school entrance) **PM pick up:** 4pm-6pm (pick up is at the front door, main school entrance)

\*Staff will escort younger child(ren) to their classroom and direct older child(ren) to their classroom \*Due to strict rules between the TDSB and childcare, ensuring we are following social distancing and minimizing groups of children into the building at one time, you are not permitted to drop off your child after 8:15am for AM care, we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. By 8:30am all children will be outside with daycare staff.

# After School & Picking up your child

Kindergarten Children- will be dismissed into the kindergarten enclosed playground, daycare teachers will pick them up from there.

*Grade 1-6 Children-* will be dismissed into the school yard at 3:30pm, daycare staff will pick up the children in their afterschool care classroom from the schoolyard.

Parents are not to enter the school building. If you need to pick up your child prior to 4:00pm, you must pick them up directly from their teacher at 3:30pm. Please inform the daycare room and let the school teacher know that your child is to remain in their care until you have arrived.

When daycare children are outside we will be using the South side of the playground (closest to the garden). Community members will be using the North side (closest to the parking lot) of the playground. We will be keeping our children in cohorts and only allowing children to play with other children in their specific cohorts.

# **Screening**

All children must be pre-screened for Covid-19 symptoms before entering the building. This can be done by using either the daycare screening forms found here: <u>paper screening form</u>, <u>google form</u> **OR** the TDSB app to show that daily screening has been completed.

If your child does not attend daycare in the morning, the screening will happen after school, younger children will be asked if they are feeling well or not well. Older children (grades 4-6) will be asked to answer all of the Covid-19 screening questions.

Your child is not allowed in daycare if they are not feeling well or if they have any symptoms of Covid-19. Everyone must stay home when sick.

## If your child will not be at daycare

If your child will not be at daycare after school, **please let the room know with as much advance notice as possible**. Leaving a voice mail message with your <u>child's room</u> the day before is preferred and also helps the afterschool teachers know exactly who they are picking up to try and avoid staff running around after school trying to locate a child who has already left.

## Same Day Special Pick Ups

The daycare cannot accommodate same day pick ups by individuals who are not already listed on your pick up authorization form. We require at least 24 hours notice and ask that you update your anytime pick up list.
