ELECTOR REGISTRATION

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on October 20, 2018
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration;
- resident of the Village of Gold River for at least 30 days immediately preceding registration; and
- not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the other property owners.
