TESTING SEASON IS STILL GOING ON

The year is quickly flying by! This means our state's standardized tests are coming up. Our school has been preparing for this and working hard for these upcoming tests.

We can make your child's test experience positive and successful by working together. Please take the time to do these little things and help your children reach their fullest potential:

- Talk with your child about goals for this test.
- **No cell phones or smart watches** are allowed on campus during testing. **The STATE department will confiscate phones and watches until all files are cleared for a possible testing breach.** Please make sure your child has a book to read.
- Make sure your child gets a healthy breakfast at home or at school on the morning of the test.
- Students may wear school approved jackets during testing, but blankets are not allowed.
- **Late and absent students** will make up missed sessions after lunch in the library. They will NOT be allowed to enter a testing session that has begun. PLEASE plan doctor's appointments around their testing if possible.
- Gently encourage your child to do their best and show your faith in them.

Below you will find a list of dates your child will test based on their current grade.

April 29-May 3rd – 3rd grade (Monday-Friday), 4th-8th (Science-Monday-Wednesday) & High School EOC Testing for English II (Monday & Tuesday), English III & Biology (Thursday-Friday) STRICTLY Timed except English III & Biology

May 6th-10th – High School EOC Testing for US History (Monday-Tuesday), Geometry (Wednesday-Friday) & English I (Wednesday-Thursday) ALL will be STRICTLY Timed Environmental Science AP and US Government & Politics AP (Monday) - English Literature & Composition AP (Wednesday) - US History AP (Friday)

May 13-15th – High School EOC makeup testing.
