#### PONDERINGS FROM PASTOR CATHIE

Greetings! To those who are reading this newsletter: "Know that you are dearly loved by God and called to be God's

people. Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ." Romans 1:7 CEB

Remember when we were complaining that spring would not arrive? Not only has spring arrived, so has summer – complete with HOT weather. Have you noticed that it takes a while for us to settle into different seasons?

On the positive side, there are some exciting things happening.

The garden at the back of our church has been expanded so we can plant more food and flowers! Stop by to watch the progress. As our garden grows, we will share the food and flowers with members and people around us. We will also give food to

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the Emergency Food Pantry.

My husband, Paul Campbell, and I set up a labyrinth on the south side of our building. If you have not stopped to see it, please save a little time to check it out. It is available any time to anyone. We are working on getting a sign so it is easier for all to

There are three steps that can help you walk the labyrinth.

see it.

 Take a few deep breaths, and say a prayer as you enter the labyrinth. While you are walking in the labyrinth, quiet your mind, focus on a concern, pray for others, or sing a song.

If there are several people walking at the same time, just remember to be mindful of others. One of the things you can do is to step aside and let others go around if they seem to be walking faster than you are.

- 2. When you get to the center, pause, stay as long as you want, appreciate the peacefulness, listen to the birds, the wind, and other items that catch your attention.
- 3. When you are ready, you return on the same path that you entered. It is a time to reflect your experience. If you like to keep a journal, sit in the grass or on the sidewalk as you write or draw your thoughts.

By the way, there is not a 'right' or 'wrong' way to walk the labyrinth. If you have children or grandchildren, bring them out to the labyrinth, so they can experiment with ways to spend time with God. Sometimes they run on the labyrinth or they sit down to think about what they experienced.

You may have noticed that we are including both July and August in this newsletter. Rev. Donna Monteith will be

preaching on July 3 as I will be returning from my adventure as a Commissioner for the 225th General Assembly in Louisville, Kentucky. I am sure you

will hear stories when I return!

During these two months we will be getting to know the Old Testament. Starting July 10, we will begin to learn, or relearn, about Amos. We will also be participating in communion during worship on July 10th.

We will spend two weeks learning about Hosea and two weeks learning about Isaiah. The last two weeks of August and the first week of September will focus on Jeremiah.

Our August Mission Focus will be Bdecan Presbyterian Church, in Tokio ND, on the Spirit Lake Reservation. We will again be collecting money to purchase winter outerwear for school-age children. They are unable to ride the bus to school or go out for recess if they don't have suitable attire. We would like to dress 20 children, at an estimated cost of \$100 per child. Envelopes will be available again this year, with suggested donations of \$5 each for mittens, caps and scarves; \$20 for a pair of snow pants; \$25 for a coat; and \$40 for a pair of boots. Clothes will be ordered in appropriate sizes and distributed to the local children in early November.
