OLDINANCE NUMBER 17.

AN ONDINANCE LICENSING THE SALE OF NON-INTOXICATING BEVERAGES AND REGULAT-ING THE BUSINESS OF VEND-ING THE SAME AT RETAIL.

The Village Council of the Village of Néw Munich, Stearns County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows: Section 1. N person shall engage in the business of selling or vending non-intoxicating peverages, at retail, within the said Vilage of New Mun-ich, without first naving obtained a license therefor. license therefor.

Section 2. Every person requiring a license under the provision of this rdinance shall pay the s Twenty-five dollars therefor. sum of

Twenty-five dollars therefor. Section 3. Every person requiring a license under the provision of this ordinance shall pay to the Village Freasurer of said Village the sum of Twenty-five dollars, taking his re-ceipt therefor, which said receipt shall be presented to the Recorder of said Village, together with an ap-plication, describing the place in which such applicant proposes to en-cage in such business, and the re-corder shall present such application corder shall present such application to the Village Council, at the next regular or special meeting of said cegular or special meetine of said council thereafter; and in case such application is granted, the Village Recorder shall issue to such applicant : license, under his hand and the seal of said Village, describing the place in which said business is to be con-ducted, granting to such a plicant the privilege of carrying on such bus-iness, at such place, for a period of one year from the date thereof, and one year from the date thereof, and thall bear date of the time of grant-ing of such application. No rense shall be for a shorter period that one year, and after the granting of such license, no part of such license money hall be refunded. In case said Vilshall be refunded. In case said Vil-lage Council should refuse to grant any such license, it shall order the return of such license money to such applicant, and the Village Reconier shall, immediately issue an order up-on the Treasurer of said Village, pay-able in the sum of Twenty-five col-lars to such applicant lars to such applicant.

Section 4. All places, except dr stores, where such non-intoxicati beverages are sold shall be closed 11 o'clock P. M. of each day and kept closed until 5 o'clock A. M., the following day, and every Sunda from 10 o'clock A. M. to 11 o'cloc A. M.

Section 5. Any person convicted of a violation of any of the proviconvicted sions of this ordinance, shall be pun-ished by a fine of not to exceed one hundred dollars, and not less than one dollar, or be confined in any place of confinement maintained by said village or in case there be no such

ORDINANCE NUMBER 18

An ordinance amending Sections 2 and 3 of Ordinance Number 17, an ordinance licensing the sale of nonintoxicating beverages and regulating the business of vending the same at retail. The Village Council of the Village

of New Munich, Stearns County, Minnesota, ordains that Sections 2 and 3 of Ordinance No. 17 be amended to read as follows: Section 2. Every person requiring

a license under the provision of this ordinance shall pay the sum of \$25.00 therefor for a period of one year, or \$7.50 therefore for a period of three months.

Section 3. Every person requiring a license under the provision of this ordinance shall pay to the Village Treasurer of said Village the sum of \$25.00 for a period of one year, or \$7.50 for a period of three months, taking his receipt therefor, which said receipt shall be presented to the Recorder of said Village, together with an application, describing the place in which such applicant proposes to engage in such business, and the recorder shall present such application to the Village Council, at the next regular or special meeting of said council thereafter; and in case such application is granted, the Vil-lage Recorder shall issue to such applicant a license, under his hand and the seal of said village, describing the place in which said business is to be conducted, granting to such applicant the privilege of carrying on such business, at such place, for the perstated in said application, and iod shall bear date of the time of granting of such application. No license shall be for a shorter period than three months, and after the granting of such license, no part of such li-cense money, whether for three months or for one year, shall be refunded. In case said village council should refuse to grant any such li-cense, it shall order the return of such license money to such applicant, and the Village Recorder shall immediately issue an order upon the Treasurer of said village, payable in the sum of \$25.00, in case the application shall be for a period of one year, and \$7.50 in case the applica-tion shall be for a period of three months, to such applicant.
