Fr. Jeff opened the meeting with prayer.

Sheila Vogt read the September 8, 2020, minutes Doug Lucius made a motion to accept the minutes & Bob Finney seconded the motion.

Pastor's Report:

- Fr. Jeff noted that he thinks the parking lot lights look great, and they really highlight our beautiful church. He wanted to thank all of the individuals/businesses involved in this project.
- Fr. Jeff explained the Mass schedule for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. The children's Nativity Play will take place before the 4:30 p.m. Mass. The 4:30 Mass will follow and will be celebrated by Fr. Sanford and assisted by Deacon Steve Vogt. Then, @ 4:45 p.m., Fr. Jeff Smith will celebrate a Mass in the Sacred Heart Parish Hall. The purpose of the Mass in the Hall, is to accommodate any overflow of parishioners that want to attend Christmas Eve Mass, but do not have seating available because of the Covid seating restrictions. Saint Joe's in Crestline will have a 7 p.m. Christmas Eve Mass as well.
- Fr. Jeff said he would like to put together some family events, but understands it is very difficult with Covid restrictions.
- Fr. Jeff also wanted to make sure that all parishioners understand that the Diocese strongly discourages the priest from congregating with the parishioners after Mass. In other words, he would love to socialize on the sidewalk after Mass, but right now he is not allowed.
- Fr. Jeff feels that Covid protocol and social distancing is going well at Mass.
- Fr. Jeff announced that the Parish will be ordering a new Roman Missal, and Altar & Rosary will be paying for it.

School Report:

- Mrs. Myers said that this year, each classroom has chosen a different charity that they will sponsor through monetary and other donations.
- The Culture Project will be visiting our school to make a presentation to the 6 8th graders. Their focus is on social media and Human dignity. (They are highly recommended by the Diocese).
- Discussion was held regarding the installation of a drop ceiling in the classrooms, in part of the hallway, and in Mrs. Cain's office. Mrs. Myers will get dimensions to Tom Metzger so he can begin to calculate an approximate cost for this project.

Old Business:

- Pot holes in the parking lot have been filled.
- Jacob Gosser and Seth Rietschlin have been working on the hot water heater that will be installed in the church restroom.
- Steve Metzger repaired the school sign in the front of the school.

New Business:

• Brief discussion was held regarding the grass in the Church Cemetery. Fr. Jeff will look into scheduling a meeting with the Cemetery committee.

Fr. Jeff closed the meeting with prayer.

Nick Vogt made a motion to adjourn and Doug Lucius seconded the motion.






