## 2025-2026 School Registration

In your registration packets for the 2024-2025 school year—once again, we are offering a SUMMER PROGRAM! Spaces for the summer program are limited so register early—dates will be finalized and costs will be included in your packet. Registration packets will be sent out on January 14th & 15th and must be returned by 10:00 am on January 29th. You will be asked to make a first & second choice of number of days you would like your child to attend for the coming school year. Every effort will be made to give families their first choice. You will be notified concerning the class your child is in for the next school year. As a reminder, registrations will be processed according to the date your family began continuous uninterrupted enrollment at APLC. At 10:00 am on January 29th, we will take all the forms we have received and put them in order according to the date continuous enrollment began. The families with the most tenure will be processed first. Depending upon enrollment, we are considering multi-age grouping—for example, older 3's & young 4's. That determination will be made as classes fill. All registrations turned in must include a \$200.00 non-refundable registration fee. #### TANTRUM-FREE SHOPPING WITH YOUR KIDS -

You're going to get in trouble. Stop it." Instead, she glances at him out of the corner of her eye, keeps walking, and finds a place just out of sight where she can watch him. He can't see her, but she can see him. Giggling, she watches him as he suddenly realizes he might be "lost." He looks around, doesn't see her, panics a bit, and begins to run down the aisle. As he turns the corner and sees her, she smiles and says, "Oh, good to see you," and continues walking. As she moves along, Randy starts to learn, "I'd better keep up with Mommy." Happiness Solution #2: When tantrums erupt, don't be afraid to be silly. Some parents follow a sure-fire strategy for making themselves miserable and ensuring that tantrums become a grocery store tradition for their kids. How? They get angry, frustrated, and say things like, "Stop acting that way! When we get home, you are really going to get it. I mean it." Love and Logic parents aren't afraid to have some fun instead.
