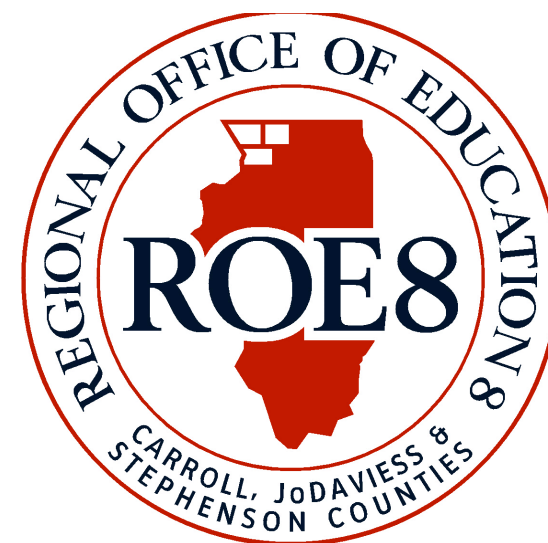

Day 1 will focus on Maslow's hierarchy of needs Ed Camp style.
