#### Update on the Komen More Than Pink Walk

The Komen Atlanta "More Than Pink Walk" will take place on **Saturday, May 5th, at Lenox Mall**. This event was formerly known as the "Race for the Cure." Atlanta is one of four pilot cities for the 2018 evolution of the 'Race' to a 'Walk.'

This year's event is "walk only" since 90% of past participants in Atlanta have been walkers. There will be more emphasis on Komen's mission, community impact and involvement, fundraising and how Komen is more than just the color pink.

The distance is also changing from a 5K (3.1 miles) to a course that is 2.25 miles. Our Team is "Cool Cruisers for a Cure" and we have been challenged to raise at least \$3,500 for the Walk this year. We are looking to have at least 10 registered team members. While Komen Atlanta does not require fundraising for the Walk, we will expect Cool Cruisers for a Cure Team Members to raise at least \$125 (which represents the cost of a mammogram). As in year's past, Komen will be providing fundraising rewards to participants who achieve certain levels of donations.

Registered team members who volunteer at Georgia Cool Cruisers events that benefit Komen will have the money raised split among their Walk fundraising accounts. Team



members are encouraged to do personal fundraising as well. You do not have to physically participate in the Walk in order to be on the Team!

## **Furkids Cruises into 2018**

Furkids and the Georgia Cool Cruisers had another wonderful year together in 2017!

Over the summer Furkids took in two kittens that were abandoned at a car show. Rick and Sharon named them Prowler and Renegade after their favorite cars and they were placed in a foster home where they grew into healthy, strong young cats. Today, Prowler and Renegade are living happily ever after together in their forever home!



Furkids also participated in the Georgia Cool Cruisers Cruise-In at the Varsity and the Cars & Costumes Halloween party at the Pink Pony. The donations collected from these two events helped us save and care for even more homeless dogs and cats!



Thanks to partnerships like the one with the Georgia Cool Cruisers, Furkids was able to do some truly amazing things in 2017. We found homes for 3,416 animals, expanded our adoption centers, created new programs and more.

Animal behaviorist and Animal Planet celebrity Jackson Galaxy, honored us by being the guest of honor at our 15th birthday gala. Jackson tours rescue organizations all over the country, and he gave Furkids highest marks during his visit to our cat shelter.

Furkids was honored to take part in a special *Atlanta Magazine* sponsored competition among nonprofits called Give Atlanta Challenge. We came in first place and earned several cash prizes and ads in the magazine.

Our adoption program is expanding with the addition of five new adoption centers with Pet Supermarket, which sells pet supplies, premium food and products. This new partnership increases our retail adoption centers to a total of 21, building on our long-time partnerships with PETCO and PetSmart and the new Happy Tabby Café.

We've long dreamed of matching our Furkids with adoption opportunities in other states. The dream became a reality when we began a partnership with Angels of Hope in Anoka, Minnesota. Last fall, we sent our first van load of Furkids, rescued from high kill shelters in Georgia, to Minnesota. There are Northern families waiting to adopt homeless cats and dogs, and we have so many in Georgia longing for loving homes. It's a match made in heaven!

Finally, during Hurricane Irma, Furkids launched a dramatic rescue of homeless cats and dogs in danger of death in coastal Georgia counties. We were blessed by a heroic team of staff and volunteers, including pilots who ran an airlift and a van driver who braved the storm on four wheels to give 120 animals a second chance.



Now, it's time to look ahead into 2018. We have some big plans, including more rescues, more adoptions, and more space for our Furkids to live and play. We can't do it without the continued support of all of our friends at the Georgia Cool Cruisers! Thank you for a great year of support and we look forward to seeing you at an event in 2018!
