Evening provider and we are so glad she has joined our team. We are looking forward to her being with us full time when her contract ends with ARH in May 2016.














Jerome Strunk ...our "NEW" transportation staff. He transports our patients from their homes to our clinic and to their pharmacies to pick up their medications.




