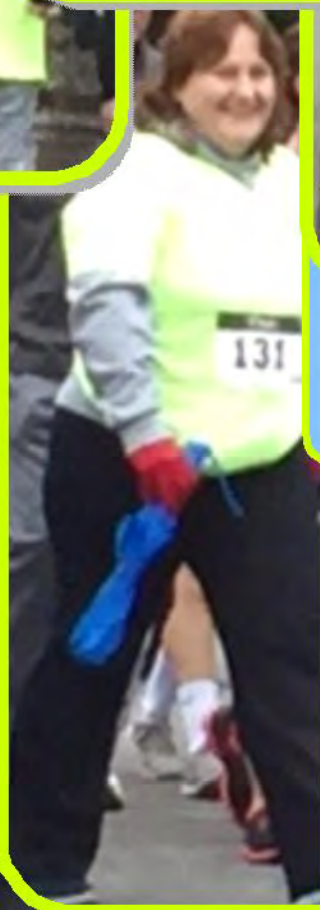
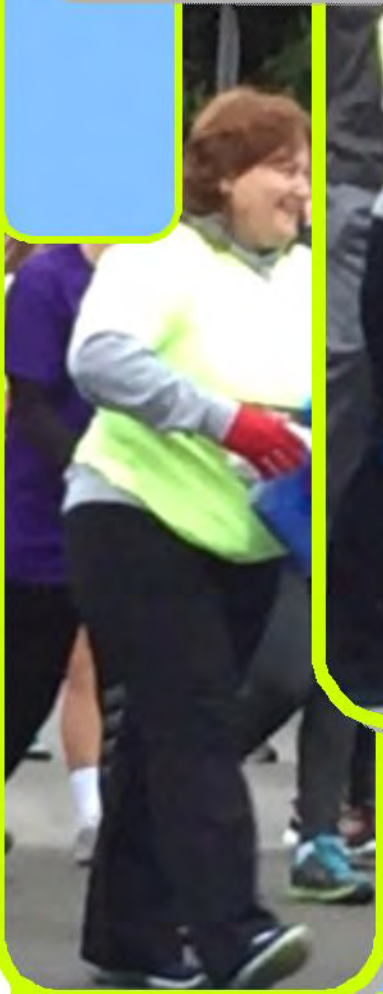
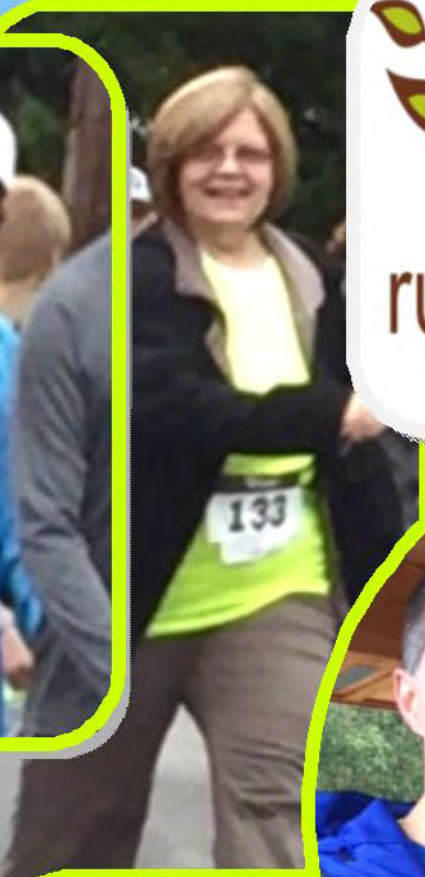
Donations to Support Little Flower Clinic were acquired by Foundation for Appalachian Kentucky in our name.

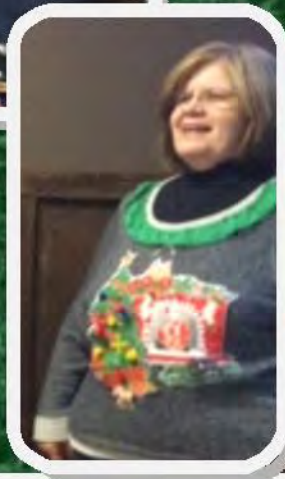
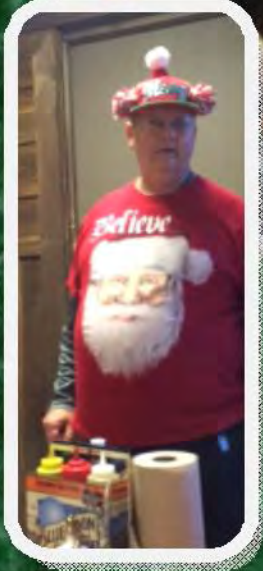
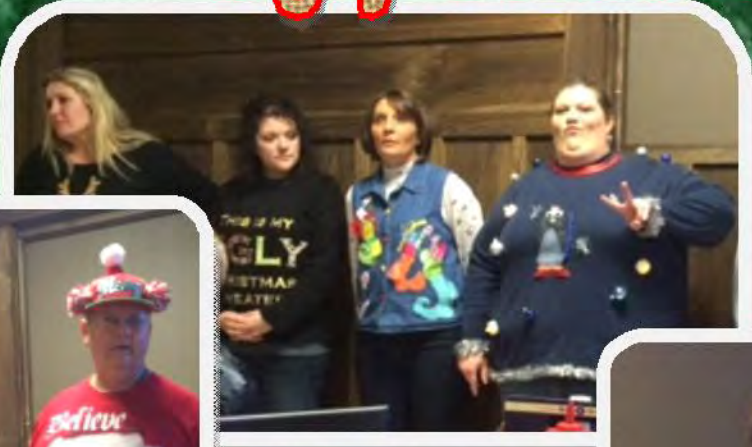
We all had a Wonderful time at Big Blue Smokehouse.... a reserved room made our Christmas Party so much fun...
