

2016 North Carolina High School Rodeo Association's Queens Contest  
Schedule and Information

Lone Hickory Arena – Yadkinville NC – May 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>

\*please note , this is a tentative schedule and events will run in order , possibly running ahead or behind depending on number of contestants \*

*Contestants will have the opportunity to earn a total of 250 points per judge. See description of events and point values below. Contestant with highest number of points wins.*

Saturday May 28th

Dress Code Description :

Western Casual – Jeans and western blouses or shirts. Long sleeves, collar and hat.

Speech/Modeling – Western Casual, with the option of suits, dresses, skirts, blouses, dress pants, colored jeans and shirts.

Horsemanship – Blue denim jeans and plain white cotton blouse or shirt with long sleeves, collar and hat. Shirt is to be plain, no ruffles, accessories, tuxedo shirts or other fancy styles allowed.

All Morning Session will be wearing the Western Casual with Speech / Modeling Dress Code option.

All morning sessions will be held in the Lone Hickory Dining room.

**8:00am** – Sharp – Breakfast Social – Lone Hickory Dining room

Queen Contestants are invited to bring up four guests to attend the breakfast social that will lead into the Introductions, Modeling and Two Minute Speech

The breakfast social will give Queen Contestants a chance to meet and mingle with other contestants, families and judges. This is not a scored event, relax and have fun!

**8:15am** – Introduction and Impromptu Questions – Lone Hickory Dining room (25 Points)

All contestants will be on stage for the introductions and will go in alphabetical order by last name. The introduction should include name, age, hometown, high school you attended. After the contestant introduces herself, she will then answer an impromptu question. After she is finished with her question and introduction she may be seated in the designated seating.

**9:00am – Modeling ( 25 points ) / Two Minute Speech (50 points ) – Lone Hickory Dining room**

Modeling – first section of Contestant’s biography will be read as she is walking to stage

Two Minute Speech Topic – Contestant can speak about North Carolina, USA, or anything with a western theme. Speeches will be timed. If the speech is not finished when the buzzer goes off, she can only complete the sentence she is currently speaking. Contestants will go in alphabetical order of first name. When contestant is finished with her speech and modeling she may sit back down in the designated seating.

**Break - before we start the Personal Interviews contestants may take a break and say good by to guests until the Horsemanship portion of contest.**

**9:30am - Personal Interviews – Lone Hickory Dining room – contestants will wait in the arena ( 50 points )**

Contestants will go in random draw. There will be a time limit of ten (10) minutes for each contestant’s interview. The contestant will sit down with the panel of six judges and answer questions ranging from current events to personal goals.

**10:15am – 10:45 Written Test (25 points) Lone Hickory Dining room**

Test will be composed of 50 Questions worth 25 Points. Test will be composed from the 2014-2016 rulebook only

**11:30am – Horsemanship Competition (50 points) - Arena**

All Queen Contestants will compete in the horsemanship competition in random draw  
A copy of the patten is provided with this information sheet.

**Through out the day - 25pts each**

Contestants will be judged on Personality (25pts) and Appearance (25pts) throughout the day
