

# Water Ski and Weekend Camping Trip

**Option One:** be a "Only Camping and No Boating Participant"

*This means you are certain you do not wish to get on a boat the entire weekend.*

This will be a "Show & Go"

- No R.S.V.P. / No Sign-Up Needed \* Cost is Free

**Option Two:** be a "Boat & Camp Participant"

*This means you want to water ski or just want to enjoy a boat ride.*

*You must decide at sign-up, so we can make sure to have the appropriate amount of boats available.*

The Club will provide: Water ski boats, gas for boats, ski equipment, & vests

**Boat Participants:**

Early Sign-up: \$40 member, \$50 non-member

After May 20: \$50 member, \$60 non-member

On-line signup credit card not charged until 2wks before trip.



*To Make Sure We Have the Correct Ratio of Boat Owners to Boat Participants Please no changes after June 12th.*

**EVERYONE** needs to:

- Provide their own transportation to the lake
- Bring your own food (breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks, & appetizer to pass on Saturday night), soda, water, drinks, and ice for the entire weekend. (The Marina or town nearby sells ice.)
- Bring your own camping gear
- Pay \$17 per night camp fee/site, pick your own sites (you can reserve online or most of us will just show up and look what's available) and you will need to pay \$6 vehicle admission into park
- Everyone can camp wherever they want. From wonderful Sandy Beach where you could reserve your own spot online now, or a non-reserved spot such as Two Moons Campground Mountain Vista, or Whisky Gulch Campground near our reserved Pavilion. Its up to you to find a spot.

Please note: Prices do not include Camp Sites and Admittance.

We will not be reserving any campsites. CAMP SITES ARE on your own. You can reserve online or most folks will just show up. Most of us will be camping near our reserved Whisky Gulch Pavillion

Make your own reservations at Hall's Glendo Marina (307) 735-4216. Note, \$4 per day use fee, but no camping fee. If you plan to be on a boat you will need to pay for Option Two.
