Nor shall we be afraid of the pestilence that walks in darkness,

Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday!

Even though a thousand may fall at our side, and ten thousand at our right hand,
We thank You Lord Jesus, that it shall not come near us!
Only with our eyes will we look and see the reward of the wicked!**
