- *The finished quilt should be no smaller than 36"x36" and no larger than 40"x54"
- *Members may enter as many completed quilts as they desire.
- *The Guild will not provide any fabric and/or supplies for the quilt.
- *Quilt must be received by the deadline of July 31st or it will not be eligible to be judged.

The quilts will be displayed, and winner announced at the August Business Meeting. Quilts will become the property of the Space Coast Quilters Guild Inc and be distributed in accordance with the Guild's goals and objectives when the Contest is completed.
