


As the Board of Education announced, all students K-5 will be receiving backpacks full of supplies needed for virtual learning. Nantucket Elementary School will be distributing these materials to families in a similar way to how we had student pickup belongings last spring. In addition to picking up a backpack of supplies, parents will update/verify Emergency Card Verification Reports from their car during this time.

Please read below for more information.

- To keep everyone safe, masks will be worn and social distancing will be maintained at all times. Please bring your driver's license/identification card and a pen.
- Pickup of supplies by car is highly encouraged by the Board of Education; however, if you don't have transportation, please come on the designated "walking-pickup" time.

The schedule for pickup at left is based on your last name. If your children have different last names, you can pick up at either time to limit your trips to school. On the day of your pickup, you may come during any of the three designated pickup times. All parking lots at Nantucket will be blocked off to discourage parking. Parents coming to the school should remain in their cars and use the drive-thru plan below.



When picking up your materials,

- 1. Enter the bus loop and stay in your car. Follow the directions of Nantucket staff.
- 2. At the green circle you are going to show your driver's license/identification card to the Nantucket staff member.
- The staff member will confirm your identification and connection with the student(s) and provide you with Emergency Card Verification Report(s).
- 4. Take the reports and pull forward toward the blue square to verify, update, sign and return the reports.
- 5. At the yellow triangle you will stop and receive the backpack for your student or students.

6. Finally, you may proceed around the access road and off of school property.

If you must walk to school to pick up your backpack on September 16,

- 1. While wearing a face mask, bring your driver's license or identification card, and a pen to the front entrance of the school.
- 2. Ring the doorbell and a staff member will meet you in the foyer to update your student's Emergency Card Verification Report and provide a backpack.
