SPECIAL ELECTION

The Dorchester County Board of Elections & Registration announces a Special Election for the **Town of St. George** to be held Tuesday the 13th day of March, 2018.

The following offices shall be included in this election:

Town Council District 1 – Unexpired Term

Books will be open for filing January 5, 2018 at noon, and will remain open during regular business hours until January 15, 2018 at **NOON**.

The polling place for this election will be St. George Town Hall, Saint George, SC 29477, as set by law.

Town Council is an unexpired term, expiring November 2019.

People desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered by Sunday February 11, 2018. To register, one must contact the Dorchester County Board of Elections & Registration.

Registered electors who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Voters wishing for more information concerning absentee voting should contact The Dorchester County Board of Elections & Registration.

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The polls shall open at 7:00 AM on Election Day and close at 7:00 PM.

At 9:00 AM on Election Day the Dorchester County Board of Elections & Registration shall begin the process of examining the absentee ballots. This examination will be held at the Dorchester County Elections Office, 235 Deming Way, Summerville.

On Thursday, the 15th of March at 10:00 AM the St. George Town Hall the St. George Board of Elections will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.
