Sewer Committee Report, April 27, 2021

General Comments from Kenny

Northview lift station electrical control box had a soft start relay replaced. This was preventative maintenance as there were some indications that the old relay was starting to fail after doing some diagnostic checks.

In Meadow Woods II subdivision construction of a new house has started on the corner of Larissa Dr & Magen St. This construction site can be seen from S Main. The plumber was not able to find the sewer service line for this lot per the ground markings. Kenny and Bert ran the camera into the main sewer line and before reaching the sewer wye and they discovered a total high speed orange pipe bored through the main sewer line not allowing the camera to go any further. Lafollette Excavating was called in and dug up approximately 15' of the main sewer line. Much of this sewer line was partially filled with small gravel. There are 2 sewer wyes one going west to the lot with the new construction and one going east to an empty lot. These Wyes are approximately 2' apart. The Total High Speed orange pipe was bored through the main sewer pipe in-between the 2 wyes (similar to hitting a bull's eye on a dart board)! This was an unknown major I and I issue because this sewer line is in the bottom of a storm water drainage ditch! The broken sewer pipe has been fixed.

CC Lift Station Update

All parts from Fluid Equipment are now delivered to us or to the other contractor Willis Bros. We need almost 2 weeks of mostly dry weather to do this project with Bert + 1 employee and Kenny doing the pre-work before Willis Bros can install the new equipment. We have had communication issues with Liberty Electric and the Mayor is now helping with that. Also, Bert is pursuing another resource person with Liberty to get some help from Liberty. The new gate is now installed in the fencing around the lift station. This will make it easier to do the bypass pumping for cleaning the 2 tanks. There are two rain storms arriving with the first one tomorrow and the second one in the next week to week and a half. When we get pass this next rain event then work will start in May with completion before the end of the month of May.
