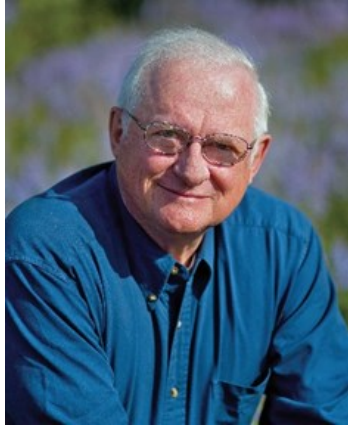


Never Curse the Rain
