PLAINTIFF'S PRE-TRIAL MEMORANDUM (for the December 16, 2019 trial date)

Plaintiff, Lyons Township Trustees of Schools, Township 38 North, Range 12 East ("Trustees"), by its undersigned counsel, The Quinlan Law Firm, LLC and Miller, Canfield, Paddock and Stone, P.L.C., submits the following for its Pre-Trial Memorandum:

Final Pre-Trial Conference: December 9, 2019

Trial: **December 16-18, 2019**

A. Brief Statement of the Case.

The Trustees are a body politic who appoints a Treasurer. The Treasurer provides financial services for a dozen school districts in Lyons Township. The School Code mandates that each school district pays its proportionate share of the Treasurer's expenses of office (because neither the Trustees nor the Treasurer have a tax base). A former Treasurer, Robert Healy, embezzled over \$1 million in school funds. While investigating this, the Trustees discovered that Healy had also provided the Defendant with two types of unauthorized and unlawful financial benefits.

First, the School Code requires that each school district conduct and pay for its own annual audit. Every school district did this except for the Defendant; Healy instead paid for the Defendant's annual audit as if it was an expense of the Treasurer's office, and it was thus allocated among all the districts. This means that each of the school districts paid for their own annual audit, and also paid for their proportionate share of the Defendant's annual audit – the other school districts were forced to use their own local tax dollars to subsidize the Defendant. There is no evidence that Healy's actions were ever authorized by the Trustees, or that the Trustees even understood what was really occurring, and, in any event, Healy's actions violated the School Code as they were not an expense of his office (they were an expense of only one district, the Defendant). The amount at issue is \$249,008.21 for Fiscal Years 2008 through 2012.

Second, the School Code requires each district to pay its proportionate share of the Treasurer's expenses. Healy permitted (again without authorization) the Defendant to offset from its proportionate share due each year the salaries of several of Defendant's own employees instead of Defendant paying it share in full. This offset was never reflected on the Treasurer's books and instead a structural deficit was created. This also violated the School Code because it means the other districts are forced to pay more than their proportionate share to make up for the Defendant's non-payment – again, the other school districts are being forced to subsidize the Defendant. The Defendant maintains that it and Healy entered into an agreement authorizing the Defendant's non-payment. This purported agreement, however, would have required an intergovernmental agreement, but the governing boards of each party did not comply with the Intergovernmental Agreement Act. And even if an intergovernmental agreement had been reached, it would have existed for one fiscal year at the most. It was not a perpetual license for

Defendant to take advantage of Healy's unauthorized wrongdoing. The amount at issue is \$1,863,691.20 for Fiscal Years 2008 through 2018.

The Treasurer is presently the custodian of about \$51 million of the Defendant's funds. The Trustees seek a declaratory judgment authorizing the Treasurer to debit these funds and make the necessary bookkeeping entries to satisfy the amounts at issue, so that the other school districts are not forced to have their tax dollars allocated to pay for the Defendant.

Defendant has filed what it calls its "Consolidated Counterclaim" and the Trustees have pending a motion to dismiss that pleading because: (a) Count I does not state any cause of action; (b) Count II fails to state a cause of action for breach of fiduciary duty because, as an elected body politic, the Trustees do not owe Defendant a fiduciary duty, and Defendant has not alleged the Trustees acted with "fraud, corruption, oppression or gross injustice," which is the proper standard governing to review the Trustees' discretionary decisions at issue; and (c) Count III fails to state a cause of action for declaratory relief since the declaratory judgments the Defendants seeks are vague and would not terminate any controversy, but only lead to further litigation.

The Trustees advance other bases for dismissing the Consolidated Counterclaim, including that Defendant has failed to join the other school districts as necessary parties, certain of Defendant's claims are not ripe, and that the Defendant present non-justiciable, political questions better resolved by the General Assembly if the legislative branch of government sees fit to amend the School Code.

B. <u>Trustees' Trial Exhibits.</u>

A list of the Trustees' trial exhibits is attached as Exhibit 1. Exhibits 1-94 were identified in advance of the September trial date and LT did not object to those exhibits (although some of those exhibits have been supplemented to include some additional materials). Exhibits 95-110 are new.

C. Witness List and Brief Summary of Direct Testimony.

Those witnesses the Trustees anticipate calling for direct examination are identified on Exhibit 2.

D. Motions in Limine.

The Trustees have not filed any motions *in limine*, but they might need to do so, depending upon this Court's ruling on pending motions addressing LT's responses to written discovery and LT's refusal to make its new witnesses available for deposition.

E. Other Materials.

The Trustees are separately submitting a trial brief with citation to legal authority. In addition, as of December 6, 2019, the Trustees have pending three motions: (1) a motion to dismiss LT's Consolidated Counterclaim; (2) a motion to compel LT to produce Dr. Kilrea and Ms. Moran for their depositions (or to bar them from testifying); and (3) a motion to compel LT to respond to written discovery and/or to strike certain of LT's allegations.

PLAINTIFF'S WITNESS LIST (FOR DECEMBER 16, 2019 TRIAL DATE)

Plaintiff, Lyons Township Trustees of Schools, Township 38 North, Range 12 East ("Trustees"), by its undersigned counsel, THE QUINLAN LAW FIRM, LLC and MILLER, CANFIELD, PADDOCK AND STONE, P.L.C., anticipates calling the following witnesses for direct examination:

Michael Thiessen. Mr. Thiessen is the current President of the Board of Trustees of Schools and has been a Trustee since mid-2012. Mr. Thiessen will explain the structure and operation of both the Trustees and the position of Treasurer. He will further testify regarding an internal investigation of former-Treasurer Robert Healy's conduct that led to both Mr. Healy's criminal conviction for embezzling over \$1 million, and the discovery that Mr. Healy had afforded Defendant unlawful and unapproved financial benefits, prompting this lawsuit. Mr. Thiessen will testify that those unapproved benefits harm the Trustees, and the other school districts they serve, forcing those school districts to unlawfully fund Defendant. Mr. Thiessen will also testify regarding the Treasurer's expenses of office in the years at issue and explain why those are proper expenses of office. Mr. Thiessen will testify that the Treasurer is

holding about \$40 million for Defendant and that declaratory relief will permit the Treasurer to transfer funds from Defendant, or otherwise make bookkeeping entries, to make whole the other school districts. Mr. Thiessen will testify, with respect to Defendant's counterclaim, that the Treasurer properly applied the recovery of proceeds from Mr. Healy's fidelity bonds to the benefit of the school districts by reducing their outstanding liabilities, explain the Treasurer's allocation of investment income, and explain the West 40 transaction.

- 2. Ken Getty. Mr. Getty is the current Treasurer, having begun serving in June 2018. Mr. Getty will explain the structure and operation of the position of Treasurer and explain the Treasurer's allocation of income, utilization of bond proceeds, and the West 40 transaction. He may explain the business records introduced into evidence and how those records show the Treasurer paid for Defendant's annual audit while the other school districts paid for their own audits. He will also explain LT's non-payment of the Treasurer's annual invoices and how that causes harm to the other school districts. He will testify that the expenses of the Treasurer's office are appropriate expenses.
- 3. **Kelly Bradshaw**. Ms. Bradshaw is an accountant and independent contractor working in the Treasurer's office. She may explain some of the business records introduced into evidence and how those records show that the Treasurer paid for Defendant's annual audit, while all of the other school districts paid for their own annual audits.
- 4. **Dr. Michael Popp**. Dr. Popp is the Assistance Executive Director of West 40, one of the districts for whom the Treasurer provides services. Dr. Popp will explain what West 40 does, and explain the West 40 transaction, including why West 40 needed to borrow money and what would have happened had West 40 not received a loan.

5. <u>Nancy Sylvester</u>. Ms. Sylvester is an expert parliamentarian who will offer her expert testimony on the meeting minutes of both parties, and their historical customs and usages as expressed through those meeting minutes. She will testify in accordance with her expert disclosure, her deposition, and affidavits she has submitted.

Ms. Sylvester advised the undersigned, when he reached out to her on December 4, 2019 to discuss her availability for trial, of a sudden and tragic personal loss that makes her testimony at trial in mid-December not practicable. The undersigned has advised opposing counsel of this fact and suggests the parties discuss with the Court during the pre-trial conference on December 9, 2019 how to proceed in light of this development.

- 6. <u>Testimony by Deposition Designations</u>. The Trustees anticipate both parties designating testimony from the following evidence depositions:
- a. <u>Dr. Elise Grimes</u>. Dr. Grimes is the former Superintendent of District 106, one of the districts at issue in this action.
- b. <u>Dr. Lisa Beckwith</u>. Ms. Beckwith is a former Director of Business Services for Defendant. (LT has indicated it will call Ms. Beckwith as a live witness.)
- c. <u>Harold Huang.</u> Mr. Huang is a former Director of Business Services for Defendant.

The Trustees anticipate both parties will also stipulate that this Court may consider testimony from Russell Hartigan's discovery deposition. (LT has indicated it will call Judge Hartigan as a live witness.)

7. Other. If permitted to take the depositions of Dr. Timothy Kilrea and Kathy Moran, whom LT is refusing presently to produce, the Trustees reserve the right to evaluate their

testimony and the right to call either individual for direct examination as an adverse witness. The

Trustees also reserve the right to call rebuttal witnesses.
