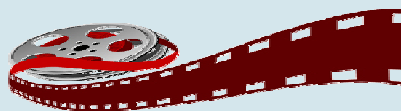

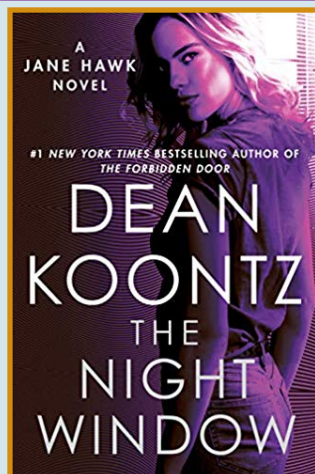

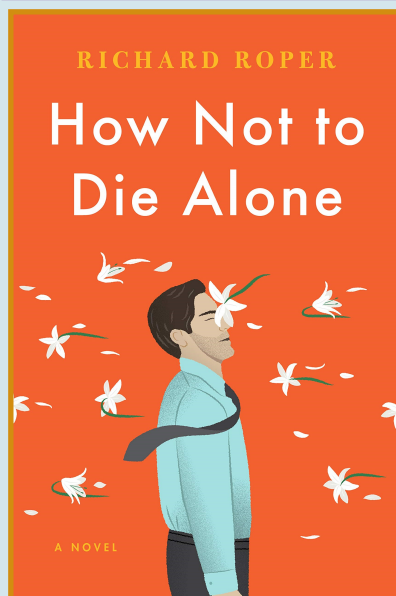


### *The Night Window - Dean Koontz*
