Regular Meeting ----- June 20, 1989

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, ATTENDANCE D. L. Taylor at 7:00 A.M. at the District office. Board members present were Gary Wilson, John Groo, and David Maki

Special Service District members present were Gary Wilson, D.L. Taylor, George White and Dan Holyoak.

Others present were Ferne Mullen, Doug Holyoak, Dale Pierson, Marsha Modine and Roberta Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meetings of the MINUTES meetings of May 16 & 19 and June 6, 1989. After calling for corrections or additions, and hearing none, the Chair declared the minutes approved as read.

Regarding the sale of the 1 cfs of Colorado River SALE OF 1CFS water rights referred to in the minutes, Roberta reported COLORADO RIVER Randy Day had gotten back with his client's offer of WATER RIGHT \$2,000.00 down, \$10,500. on September 8th and the remainder of \$12,500 in semi-annual payments over 2 years at 12%. She reported she had called D.L. and he felt this was near enough to the original proposal that a special meeting to approve this deal was not necessary. The Board agreed by consensus to proceed with the sale.

The river rights were discussed and transferring the right to the city was discussed. The problem with this is that the City could not deed it back if the District wanted it. Options were discussed and Dale was asked to discuss these options with Mark and report back at the next meeting.

The Corbin well is pumping both into the lower end CORBIN WELL of the line, also the mid portion of the system, but the reservoir is down 150 acre feet from the projection. D.L. asked if the customers are cooperating and Dale reported there is some confusion. There about 20 meters that are not in, because of lack of flange adaptors. Wells and costs were discussed. Dale reported we had permission to use the 400 AF in the conservation pool. Gary asked if the meters could be read by the next meeting and the District will have to be prepared to enforce water use restrictions in a fair manner, and D.L. suggested the meters be read and check on the use. Gary suggested checking to see if the Beeman Well could be put into the system. Dale will check into the costs of putting that well on line.

John Groo asked if the City of Castle Valley could CASTLE VALLEY be given were use of the old RWAU office for the Castle Valley Water

rights office, and some of Marsha's time in entering data on the computers. Dan moved the Castle Valley Water Rights Office be given the right to use that office space, together with use of staff time. Bill seconded. MOTION PASSED.

Marsha passed the Tax worksheets to those present TAX RATE and explained them line by line. George moved the tax rate for the Special Service Water District in Grand County be set at .000436. Dan seconded the motion. MOTION PASSED. Dan moved the proposed tax rate for the Special Service Water District in San Juan County be set at .000564. George seconded. MOTION PASSED. Gary moved Grand County Water Conservancy District proposed tax rate be set at .000436. Groo seconded. MOTION PASSED.

Marsha handed the May financial statement to those FINANCIAL present and discussed it line by line basis.
