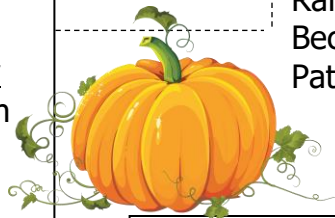
Meeting Changes

FIRST VIRTUAL KY AREA CONVENTION

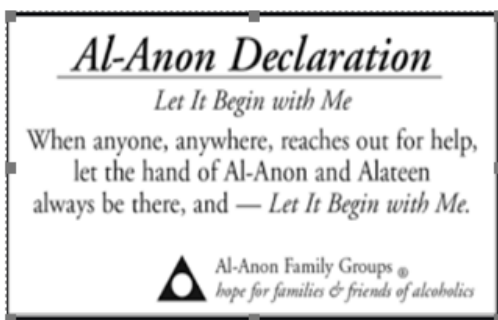
September 18 - 20, 2020
