Online vs Paper Entry Primary Limits:

GSDCO is accepting online entries for this trial through the AKC Agility Online Entry Services. Go to www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% (220 runs) Paper entries: 67% (440 runs). If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

Envelopes and/or transactions containing entries for more than (10) dogs (the maximum allowed) shall be treated as an invalid entry.

ENTRY LIMITS – Limited to 660 runs per judge, per day. Please send in your entry early to avoid being left out should this trial fill. Closing date is Friday, April 26, 2019 at 11:00 pm.

A100% refund of the entry fee will be given for any bitch that comes into season with written notification from a veterinarian provided to the Trial Secretary.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g. walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20", 24" and 24C" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk through.

CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING TIMES

Classes Offered

All levels of Standard STD, JWW and FAST, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. (International Sweepstakes Classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.** The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

Preferred Class Information

You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

Move-ups and Errors

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing (mail or email) by **6 pm, Pacific time, Monday, May 6, 2019**. Requests for move-ups over the phone **will not be accepted**. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted on the move-up form provided, to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes after completion of the last class of the day. As per Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show rules, no dog may be Moved Down in classes or jump heights after the trial closes. **PLEASE READ YOUR CONFIRMATIONS!!** Owners are responsible for errors in the entry, regardless of who may make such errors.

AWARDS, RIBBONS AND PRIZE INFORMATION

Awards

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the show. Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

First Place: Blue Ribbon ~ Second Place: Red Ribbon ~ Third Place: Yellow Ribbon

Fourth Place: White Ribbon ~ Qualifying Score: Dark Green Rosette

MACH & PACH ribbons and bars will be presented to dogs completing those titles if you & your dog are close to a MACH or PACH, please let a member of the trial committee know.

If you know you are about to run for your MACH or PACH, PLEASE remind us at the score table. We are often busy with scoring and generally working at the trial and we don't want to miss the celebration with you.

Highest Scoring German Shepherd Dog: We will be presenting the Cathie Wilce Memorial Award to the highest scoring GSD. It is open to all GSD's regardless of competition level. The Highest scoring GSD will be determined as the GSD with a 2 run total closed to 200 (Std & JWW) from Saturday's qualifying runs. In case of a tie of points, the GSD with the highest average YPS (2 runs) will win, and if still a tie the GSD with the fastest YPS in the standard run will win. The winning GSD will receive a HIT rosette.

High Combined in Trial: We are pleased to award High Combined in Trial for each level for Saturday's Standard and JWW qualifying runs. This is open to all dogs entered into the trial, regardless of breed. The dog's Standard level determines level. In case of a tie of points, the dog with the highest average YPS will win, and if still a tie the dog with the fastest YPS in the standard run will win.

Excellent Level: The highest scoring dog will be determined as the dog with a 2 run total closest to 200 in Standard and JWW Classes on Saturday's runs. The winning dog will receive a HIT rosette.

Open Level: The highest scoring dog will be determined as the dog with a 2 run total closest to 200 in Standard and JWW Classes on Saturday's runs. The winning dog will receive a HIT rosette.

Novice Level: The highest scoring dog will be determined as the dog with a 2 run total closest to 200 in Standard and JWW Classes on Saturday's runs. The winning dog will receive a HIT rosette.

OBSTACLES AND EQUIPMENT

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. There will be no equipment familiarization at this trial. As of 9/1/06 AKC does not allow it. Rubberized contacts will be used at these trials.

ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breed dogs** listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/24C" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/24C" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the Dogs To Be Measured List. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.** For complete details on the Jump Height Card Process go to www.k-9sports.com and click on the link on the Events page.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. **Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.**
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial, less all fees, for injured or ill handlers, and injured or ill dogs. 100% refund will be given to bitches in season. No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial. Verification from a doctor or vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- The German Shepherd Dog Club of Oregon, Clark County Fairgrounds and K-9 Sports LLC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- The German Shepherd Dog Club of Oregon does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth in the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- The German Shepherd Dog Club of Oregon may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

Ring & Crating Information

There is plenty of crating at this site. All crating is on concrete, around the periphery of the rings. Please do not block exits/entrances, and do not crate on any elevated platform you may find around the ring(s). You may arrive for crating set-up after 4:00 pm on Thursday.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
