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# **NEW SERVICES**

### THE PROGRAMS MUST GO ON...

The past year has been an unprecedented time for our community. Like many local businesses, the library closed for 75 days - but we were determined to return with the needs and safety of our community in mind.

Take Home Programming was unveiled in June 2020 - featuring Storytime Bags, Little Explorer Boxes, and crafts for all ages! Each Take Home Kit reflected all of our favorite library events: Craft Kits included all supplies needed (plus a candy or two) for paintings, wreaths, and more; Storytime Bags featured themed picture books with an accompanying craft and snack; and Little Explorer Boxes encouraged little ones to learn through imaginative play with tactile items and a boardbook.



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A new addition to our program line-up, Tween & Teen Book Bundles offered a convenient and exciting way to keep older kids engaged. Each bundle featured chapter books or graphic novels, paired with a craft and surprise to enjoy! Also new to our calendar, Movie Night To Go encouraged you to relax at home with two movies (selected by our librarians) - popcorn included!





### SUMMER BOOK SALE

The Library hosted its first Summer Book Sale in August 2020, featuring thousands of books and movies - all for \$1 per bag.





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We were pleased to announce Princh, a wireless printing solution. With Princh, you can print at the library using your own mobile device or laptop, and pay via credit card, cash or check!

# REFERENDUM

To address increasing minimum wages, the library submitted a public question to voters on April 6, 2021. The referendum proposed an additional 0.04% in taxes to be used toward staff wages, library collection materials, programs, and dues for PrairieCat (which is the consortium that supports Interlibrary Loans), Libby eBooks, etc. For a property with a net taxable value of \$40,000 the proposed increase would equal \$16 in one year. In total, your library taxes account for less than 3% of your total property taxes.

The initiative did not pass, as the library was short about 100 votes. Because public libraries do not operate on a profit margin and are not typically allowed to save monies, increased property tax revenue is the primary avenue for adjusting to financial challenges. Indeed, a lack of additional income necessitates budget cuts.

Sherrard Public Library District's ballot measure to increase property taxes by less than 1/2% would alleviate many of these difficult decisions, so we intend to present this public question again in 2023 - stay tuned!

In the meantime, the Library will be operating on new hours namely, closing on Friday's at 5 PM, beginning August 2021.

New operation hours will be:

Monday - Thursday: 10 AM - 8 PM

Friday: 10 AM - 5 PM

Saturday: 9 AM - 12 PM

Sunday: CLOSED



# READING PROGRAMS


### SUMMER READING PROGRAM

Each Summer, the Library offers a reading program that helps your family prevent the "summer slide" in reading skills through engaging goals and rewards. This year, 119 community members participated in Summer Reading!



425 Books Read by Adults & Young Adults

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28,080 Minutes Read by Children

### 1,000 BOOKS BEFORE KINDERGARTEN

Children ages 0-5 are eligible to participate in 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten, available year-round. Families can read any book with their child to participate, and children will be rewarded for their progress for every 100 books read! This is a great program for building pre-reading skills necessary for academic success.

# **OUR COLLECTION**

The Library offers the latest books, audiobooks, graphic novels, and movies for Adults, Teens, Tweens, and Children at all reading levels! Check out some of our collection highlights:

### **HOMESCHOOL & EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES**

Science experiments, writing prompts, early word development, art instruction and more await in our Juvenile Nonfiction section. Homeschooling families can also utilize our Homeschool Collection for curriculum development guides, and textbooks for early readers, grade school and high school students.

# **BEGINNING READERS**

Children who are starting to sound out stories will find our Beginning Readers section to be the perfect mix of easy words and fun illustrations. Be sure to also look for our First Little Readers packs, which include a small collection of storybooks correlated with a specific letter of the alphabet. Toddlers will also enjoy our Boardbook collection. Made from cardboard, these books can handle a little more wear-and-tear than picture books

### **GRAPHIC NOVELS**

Like traditional novels, graphic novels have exciting plots and are full of text. With more illustrations, however, many reluctant readers find graphic novels to have the extra support they need to finish a book. These are also a great option for children moving from picture-books to chapter books!






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



### TOP CIRCULATING NON FICTION TITLES








#### TOP CIRCULATING FICTION TITLES
