
YOUTH CONTESTS

The contest features the theme, "It All Comes Back to You." The slogan presents multiple messages: a recycled product or material can return to consumers as another product; recycling comes back to consumers as an improved environment; and it is everyone's responsibility to recycle.

Create something relating to recycling. Paint, draw a picture, write a poem, create a game, compose or sing a song, make a short video, write an essay, mold a sculpture or create a collage including a theme of recycling. Teachers may assign a media as part of a classroom assignment.

One winner for the three age groups will receive an award of \$75 gift card. The winner's associated group/teacher receives a \$100 gift card.
