

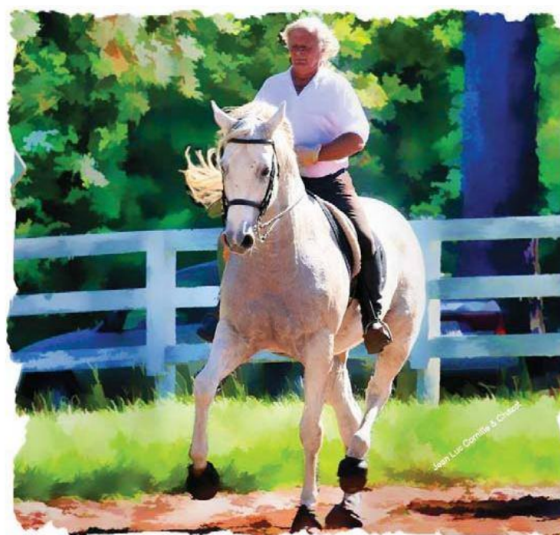

Jean Luc Cornille is an international level three-day event rider and “trainer of trainers” that has extensively studied equine anatomy and movement. His research has allowed him to develop a method that can be used to help the horse learn to move correctly and efficiently, resulting in lightness, self-carriage and the ability to reach its full athletic potential without injury. Every horse moves differently. None move perfectly, especially with a rider on their back. Even minor defects in gait can eventually result in lameness or suboptimal performance. Science of Motion is a new approach to training and therapy that is based upon identifying and correcting specific gait abnormalities inherent in each horse and equally important, adjusting the rider's posture and position.
