FastRawViewer

We needed it. We made it. We share it.

Problem Statement

Nasim Mansurov, Photography Life, 9/27/22:

- No matter what software one uses for post-processing photographs, the process of selecting what images to keep and work on, also known as “**culling**”, can be quite painful when dealing with thousands of images.
- And this gets even more painful when working with RAW images because **operating systems usually have no built-in capabilities to view and properly render RAW files**.
- Many photographers **end up keeping all RAW images on their computers**, because they do not want to go through the **hassle of deleting bad images** they will never use, only to realize over time that their hard drives get filled up quickly and their post-processing time takes much longer.
- Those who try to cull images in Lightroom know that if a full-size image preview is not generated at the time of import, it can take a long time to render each image. Sadly, **Lightroom is quite weak at quickly previewing images**, so
- working pros and enthusiasts usually end up complementing the culling part of their workflow with additional software like **Photo Mechanic**. **At \$150**, however, Photo Mechanic costs as much as a retail version of Lightroom, becoming a cost barrier for many.
- **Enter FastRawViewer, an amazingly fast and truly inexpensive RAW file viewer** that has become my personal choice for culling images.

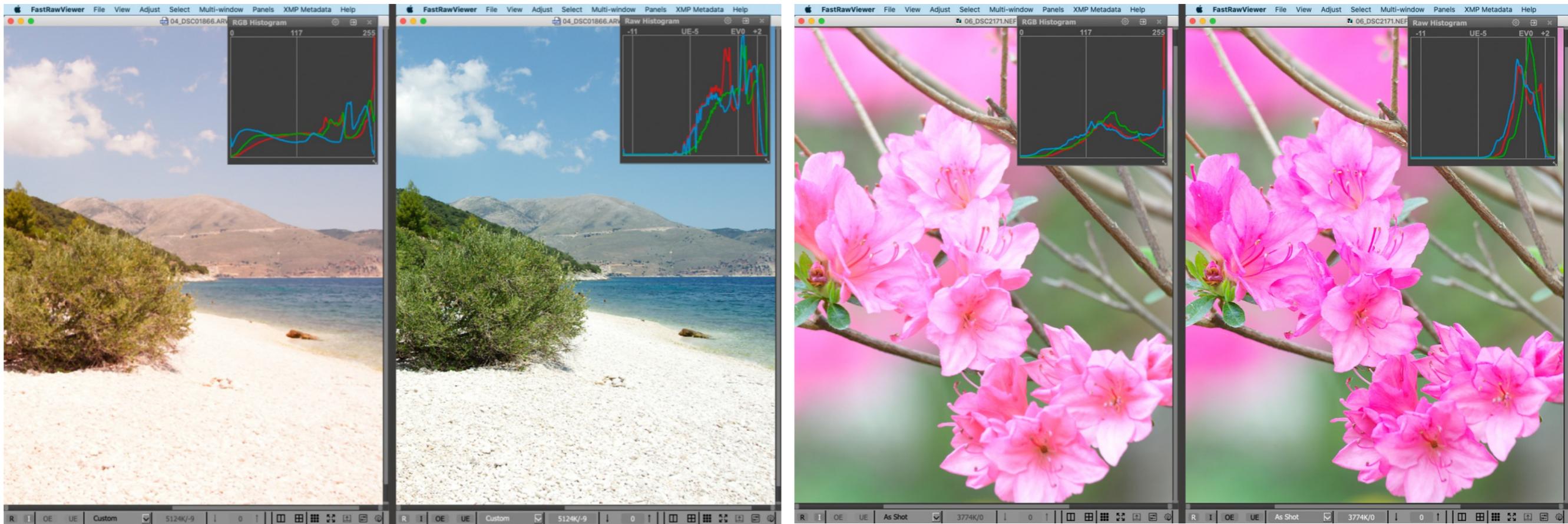
Summary

- “Only viewer to work directly with RAW and not the embedded JPEG or uncontrolled RAW conversion”
- Fast browsing speed, through any amount of RAW shots
- Any file system, any media
- No intermediate catalogues, no wasted disc space
- Non destructive edits
- See and correct exposure, focus (sharpen), and noise and saves adjustments as XMP files for Adobe inputs
- Fully customizable interface

Accurate

- “The only real WYSIWYG RAW viewer”
- Allows a photographer to see the RAW exactly as a converter will “see” it, without any delays or waiting time, guaranteeing the possibility to sort and cull RAW images lightning fast and based on the quality of the RAW itself, not JPEG previews.

Histograms: Embedded JPEG \neq RAW



Fast

- Opens RAW files extremely quickly and renders them on-the-fly, instead of just displaying embedded JPEGs.
 - 6-15 frames per second up to 50MP
 - 30-50 FPS for cinemaDNG files
 - SSD preferred

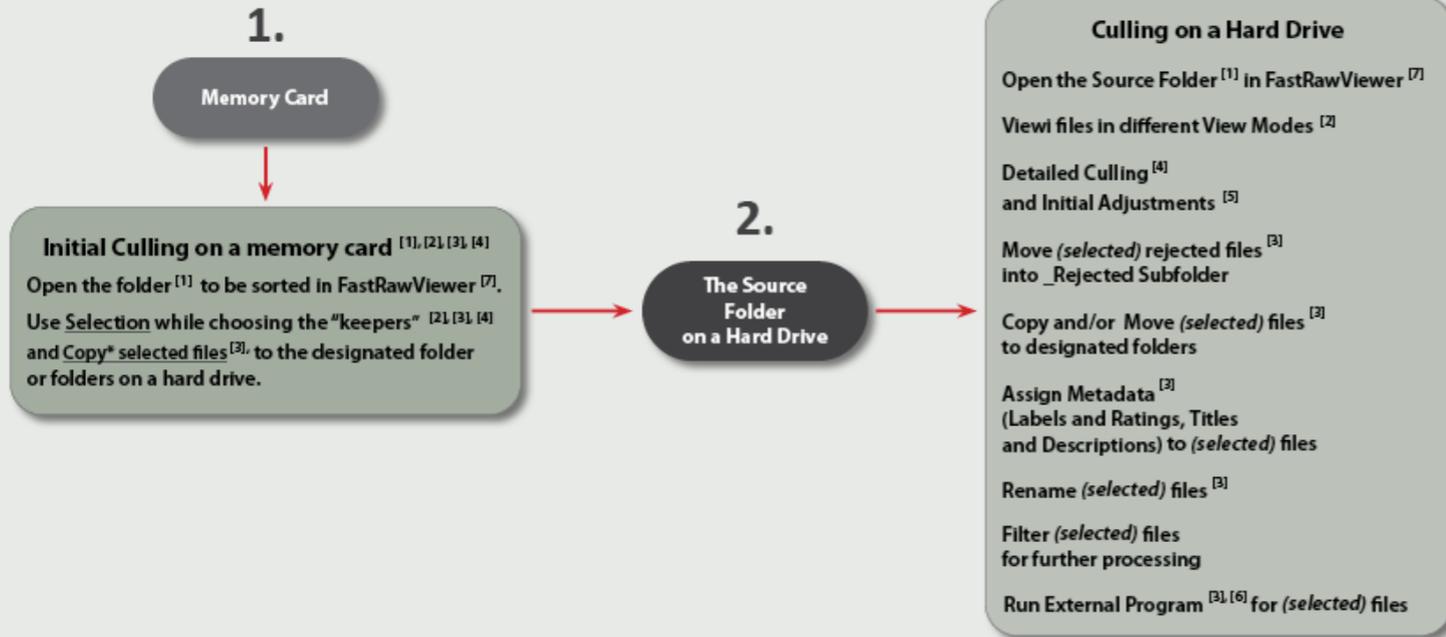

Culling _Rejected^{[1]-[5]}
Check the rejected images, and if necessary move some (or all) of them from the _Rejected subfolder back to the Source Folder or any other chosen folder.
Then the _Rejected subfolder can be cleared.

[4] Technical Tools for Culling based on RAW data:

2. OE-, UE indication and Statistics

[6] Integration with External Programs

1. Choose up to 10 external programs,
2. Launch an external program directly from FastRawViewer for a single or multiple selected files.
3. Assign Keyboard shortcuts to external programs and match an Image display

[2] Viewing Files in Different View Modes:

1. Grid View Mode
2. Single View Mode
3. Multi-window View Mode (2/4 windows)

[5] Image Adjustments

1. Orientation
2. Exposure (brightness)
3. White Balance
4. Contrast (Tone) Curve

User adjustments are recorded as XMP sidecar files in the current folder with images

[7] Fully Customizable Interface
For customization use:

1. FastRawViewer Preferences
2. Keyboard Shortcut Editor
3. Panels' Option gear icons

*** We do not recommend using "move" operations while working with a memory card or a network server. Also we do not recommend assigning labels and ratings while working with a memory card.**

Simple Workflow

- One time setup: create “reject” shortcut key (X)
 - Ctrl K or File / Customize / Keyboard Shortcuts
 - Set the 3rd menu item (File/Copy/Reject) set “Move current file to _Rejected subfolder” to your preferred key and click OK
-
- Insert memory card
 - Open FastRawViewer
 - Navigate to photo folder on your card
 - Cull images to “rejected” folder using arrow and X keys
 - Load keepers to Lightroom (import folder on desktop)
 - Review rejects one more before formatting the card

Rule Presets



To add a new rule to the current rule set, either click on one of the available rules in the list to the left of the rule edit area, or select a rule from the main tool bar by clicking on the Add Rule button. The rule will automatically be added to the list of rules in the rule set list in the center of the rule edit area, and its details will be shown right of the rule list.

- Add Space Add space before, after or around various types of characters.
- Add Text Simply add some text.
- Add Numbers Add numbers started and stepped at any value. The order of ascension is specified in the rule, and so is independent of the sort order of the file list.
- Add Date/Time Add the date and/or time. The date and time can come from the current system time or the file time based information.
- Add Path Name Add any part of the file path.
- Remove Space Remove, or condense, space (and other characters).
- Remove Text Remove a number of characters from any position.
- Remove Numbers Remove numbers (and surrounding characters).
- Add Music Tag Add an MP3 music tag.
- Add Image Tag Add an EXIF image tag.
- Replace Text Replace text. Text can be normal text, wildcard, or regular expressions.
- Replace Numbers Replace numbers. Numbers can be added, subtracted, multiplied, divided or simply have their format changed.
- Replace Date/Time Replace date/time. Date/time can be added, subtracted or simply have their format changed.
- Change Case Change the case.
- Split Name Split based on dividing characters, and swap, move, copy or delete the parts.
