2. FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 DRAFT BUDGET DISCUSSION

3. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

APRIL. 2022

Doc: We are 10 months or 83% of the way through the year. Every line well within budget.

Interest @ 408% and property taxes @ 99% remain higher than expected. Revenue at 79% and Total Expenses at 35%.

Unrestricted Funds for August @ \$5,711,466.15 and Restricted Funds @\$971,844.92 for a Grand Total Fund Balance of \$6,683,311.07.

Peggy: How much are we spending on paving?

Scott: \$105K.
