If a leak is found and fixed PLEASE BRING THE RECEIPT TO THE NEXT MEETING AS IT WILL BE PROVIDED TO THE CITY OF ARVADA and CREDIT GIVEN. If the bill does not change it will set precedence for next Summers Water Bill and the boards budget.

Speed Limit in Complex: It is posted that the SPEED LIMIT IS 5
