Mavica Challenge

At this same shoot-out, you're invited to use one of Tony's Sony Mavica's to make some images (approx. ten are available). These cameras from the mid-90's used state of the art technology to store the jpeg image files on floppy discs. If you want to participate, you will be randomly assigned a camera and one floppy

and use the “special effects” built in the camera. **But** you can only turn-in **five!** Meaning, you will have to delete and delete until only five remain when you turn-in the camera and floppy at 5 pm. Tony will then download the files and put them into some sort of presentation to show at the April 16th meeting (no post-processing will be done other than resizing to fit presentation format).
