~Officer Reports~

- ◆ **Seneschal** - Lord Edmund reported that our books were reviewed at Mermaids. The barony is doing well. He also asks for award recommendations.
- ◆ **Chatelaine** - THL Aesa reported that she has received one new info request and there have been new people interested in fighter's practice.
- ◆ **Exchequer** - Eyfrior reported that all checks are cleared. The books were reviewed at Mermaids. If anyone would like to see the report, she will have it with her. There are a number of different improvements to be made in the future, but she has started working on them. For example, they would like us to keep more hard copies of different things like the financial report at the business meetings and PDF (static) copies of Ledgers, quarterly reports, etc. She will be working on this list over the summer. She has also checked with some people about misplaced event documentation for 2016 Fighter School and 2017 Crown Turney. Greetings Lords and Ladies of Windhaven! We have three items for our Baronial Policies that need your vote.

The first is changing the office name from Archery Captain to Archery Marshal.

The second is changing the office name from Rapier Captain to Rapier Marshal.

The third is moving the following policy from Section I General to Section V Financial: The Sovereigns of Northshield are not required to pay site and feast fees for an event financially sponsored by Windhaven. This privilege would extend to thier Heirs in the Sovereign's absence. Waiving of fees for other visiting royalty must be individually approved at a business meeting or a quorum of Great Officers.
