## **COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **DAY CAMP REGISTRATION BEGINS JUNE 19<sup>th</sup>**

Goulds Recreation Association will be opening up registration for our Summer Day Camp Program on Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

Registration will begin at 9am and will take place ON-LINE only. Visit [www.gouldsrecreation.com](http://www.gouldsrecreation.com), the summer day camp registration link will be on our website's homepage. In-person or over the phone registration is not available at this time.

Due to public health restrictions, Goulds Recreation will be offering a reduced participant capacity for our day camp. There will be only 1 day camp this summer at our Rec Centre location, and our initial registration will be restricted to 20 participants.

We encourage parents/guardians to waitlist for the program if they are unsuccessful in securing a space on registration day. As public health restrictions are hopefully reduced, our participant capacity may increase, allowing us to accommodate waitlisted individuals.

Participants wishing to register for our day camp must meet the eligibility requirements as outlined by the Provincial Public Health Guidelines ( <https://www.gov.nl.ca/covid-19/information-sheets-for-businesses-and-workplaces/guidance-for-summer-day-camps/> ). Everyone, including staff, children, parents/guardians, delivery persons and guest speakers must be proactively screened for COVID-19 symptoms, travel history, and contact with person(s) who may have COVID-19 prior to each time they enter the day camp premises.

The provincial government advises that participants in day camp be fully trained and able to feed themselves independently. It is also recommended that those considered particularly vulnerable to the effects of COVID-19 or who have family members considered vulnerable in this way use discretion in availing of our day camp program.
