JUNE NEWSLETTER 2020

Accurate information in this age of COVID-19 is a moving target, but as I write this for publication, I am excited to learn that Louisiana will enter Phase Two of re-opening the economy later this week. According to the governor's announcement, that means that congregations can re-gather in their sanctuaries at 50% capacity. If the CDC physical distancing numbers I am hearing prior to official announcement are true, we will be able to mark our pews to achieve seating for the number of people I anticipate returning to worship in the coming weeks. That makes my heart go pitter-patter.

We still have work to do that will be based on the official announcement from the CDC when it comes. We must decide how many of our traditions are safe in this age of contagious disease and how to change the ones that are not safe. We must decide how to provide meaningful music without spreading disease. We must secure and train volunteers who will help people remember to practice safe guidelines. Ughhh!

We have supplies on order for disinfecting surfaces. It is on backorder. Some companies won't even accept orders yet. We have ordered wall mounted hand sanitizing stations and refills. They are scheduled for shipment in late June. We are securing disinfecting wipes from all available sources. If you have enough for your own use, would you consider sharing your excess?

We will have our first service soon. I wish I could announce a date, but that must wait until the moving target of information pauses for a few minutes. We will have a Vesper service, which is a prayer service held in the evening, one evening in the next week or so. Keep your ear to the ground; we will get the word out as soon as the service is set.

You probably know to expect things to be different, although less limiting than Phase One has been. You will be asked a set of questions about your health and possible recent COVID exposure. You will be expected to wear a mask to protect others and potentially, yourself. You will be guided to a seat. You will sit with your household with appropriate distances between households. We can't have any physical contact. Congregational responses will be limited in some ways – primarily in robustness. Can you mouth the words or whisper behind your mask? We have two beautiful wooden boxes to receive your pledges, tithes, and additional gifts (thank you Mike Hill), because we cannot pass the offering plates from hand to hand. These are by the entrance/exit of the sanctuary for you to drop your offering through the opening in the lid. Everyone will be asked to enter through the glass doors on Main Street.

None of this means that we have to be dull curmudgeons. I invite you to compete for prizes as I look for the 3 or 4 people at each service who are having the most fun with social distancing guidelines. Categories will be moving targets. Judging will be by me and completely subjective. (I'll accept your suggestions!) Funniest mask. Most creative socially distanced greeting. Show us what you can do! Let's turn these lemons into lemonade.

Seriously though, let's love one another and protect one another. If you should, for your health or the health of someone in your household stay away a bit longer, that's both ok and the right choice. Potential exposure to the virus is a risk every individual must measure for themselves. Phase Two, here we come!!! Yay!!
