## ORDINANCE NO. 22-11

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 21 LIQUOR ARTICLE II – LICENSES OF NEWTON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Newton, Jasper County, Illinois that 21-2-7 (B) be amended as follows:

(B) Class "B" which shall permit the retail sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on or off the premises where sold, and not for resale in any form. The annual license fee shall be One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). There shall be no more than four (4) licenses issued during any year.

Except as amended hereby, ARTICLE II shall remain in full force and effect according to its original terms and amendments thereto.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
