We'll be meeting at the Fountain Hills Unified School District Learning Center MAP since that facility offers us the best space and allowance if the meeting should run late. Credentialing begins at 6:00 PM and the call to order will be at 7:00 PM sharp. The credentialing process takes a little time, and ballots will only be given to those who are properly credentialed, so please don't come late. Extra parking is available in the high school parking lot to the east and the Golden Eagle Park lot to the north of the Learning Center building.

# OCTOBER 11, 2018 MEETING MINUTES - Tim Horn

7:00PM, Call to Order, Nancy Ordowski, LD23 Chair

Prayer - Rich Rutkowski, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Chair; Pledge of Allegiance - Tim Horn, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice Chair

- 1. Introductions of LD23 ExCom: Nancy
- 2. Introductions of elected officials in attendance: Nancy: (Sheila Muehling, MCR Treasurer, Jay Lawrence, AZ state legislator, among those in attendance)
- 3. Introductions of new PCs, candidates and other guests: Nancy
- 4. Announcements: Nancy: After Feb 19 new PCs can be recruited. State Representative Jay Lawrence has campaign material to distribute with "Golden Tickets".
- 5. Sign Up: a sheet was passed to sign up for call center work for Gov. Doug Ducey.
- 6. Tim Horn showed a YouTube video (TimHornNPV) and spoke re opposition the National Popular Vote and Get Out The Vote (GOTV).
- 7. Candidate speakers, Rich: **Kathleen Winn**, candidate for the Maricopa Community College District Board. **Erv Heimbuck** and **Ronda Shumway Doolen**, candidates for EVIT (East Valley Institute of Technology) Governing Board.
- 8. The November 29 LD23 Organizational Meeting will be held at the FHUSD Learning Center in Fountain Hills. Michael Loverine is again Chairman of the Nominating Committee with Ted Green, Linda Rizzo, Candice Mann, and Larry Hagan also serving on that committee. Intent to Run forms for officer and state committeeman must be submitted and received by no later than 5 PM on October 29. Forms are available at <a href="https://www.ld23gop.org">www.ld23gop.org</a>.
- 9. November 6 Ballot Propositions, Nancy: Propositions beginning with "1" are proposed amendments to the state constitution and, if approved, can only be changed by another citizen referendum.

Prop125 - This is expand upon an earlier constitutional proposition and institute cost-saving changes for state employee pensions. Vote "YES" is advised.

Prop 126 - This would block application of the transaction privilege tax on

services which are not currently subject to that tax. A "NO" vote would allow the tax to

be applied equally to all services and nothave government pick "winners"

and "losers." Vote "NO" is advised.

Prop 127 – This would mandate AZ utilities to have 50% of the state's electricity to come from "renewable" (solar and wind) sources, but is expected to restrict use of nuclear power and substantially raise costs to consumers. Vote "NO" is advised.

- 10. Election volunteers Salmon-colored permission papers were distributed to volunteer poll watchers.
- 11. State Committeemen: A.R.S. provides for one SC position for every three PCs in our District. Hence, we are allowed to elect 107 SCs on November 29.
- 12. Treasurer's report from Valerie Giramberk, Treasurer; the balance is \$10,155.49.
- 13. The Minutes from the September 13 meeting were accepted, and the meeting was adjourned at 8:39 PM.
