Good evening trustees, my name is . I am the parent of a sophomore.

I am submitting into the public record facts relative to wireless radiation and the health of the students and teachers.

My previous comments addressed how microwave radiation adversely affects learning. In addition to the previous governmental reports cited is the 1981 NASA report, entitled "Electromagnetic Field Interactions With The Human Body: Observed Effects and Theories". On pg. 30 Table 11 is listed: headaches, nervous tension, mental depression, memory impairment, dizziness, and fatigue, among others.

The May 2015 Canadian Medical Association Journal reported on Health Canada's wireless. The Journal "interviewed multiple international experts in radiation and cancer, who warn that the microwave levels allowed in Canadian classrooms, residences, and workplaces are, "a disaster to public health." One scientist said that given the overwhelming evidence that wireless radiation is harmful, Health Canada staff are either "unwilling or not competent to make evaluation of the current literature." Frank Clegg, past president of Microsoft Canada is quoted in the article, "That Canada's wireless safety code is out of date and mired in conflict of interest is no longer a question, it's a fact." So, why should we care about Canada's wireless limits? The answer is that they are essentially the same limits as our U.S. FCC guidelines.

A recent news story from Canada reports on two teachers' unions wanting Wi-Fi to be banned in area schools, citing the thousands of science studies demonstrating adverse health effects, including Electrohypersensitivity.

Another recent story out of Canada is a students' appeal for the government to "step in and protect students." A quote from one of the students, "I did not consent to this level of risk. The School Board has been informed that our WiFi system puts us at risk of infertility and breast cancer but it's choosing not to protect us."
