Spackman's Opus unit starts filming of two movies

SINGAPORE (July 13): Spackman Entertainment Group, the production company for Korean movies, announced that two movies, Musudan and Chasing, have started filming this month.

The two movies are presented and distributed by wholly owned subsidiary Opus Pictures which means Opus will be responsible for the financing, marketing and international sales for these two movies.

Musudan tells the story of a 24-hour skirmish between North and South Korean soldiers as they race to solve a series of mysterious murders in the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ).

The mystery thriller stars Lee Ji-ah, Kim Min-jun and Oh Jong-hyuk.

Chasing is an action comedy about an all-night high-speed chase involving a former famous mobster, a sloppy detective, and an uncontrollable group of high school students.

The comedy features veteran actor Kim Seung-woo, Kim Jung-tae and Hyuk, from the K-pop idol group VIXX.

Both movies are expected to be released in Korean theatres by the end of 2015.

Spackman Entertainment Group closed 0.2 cent higher at 10.1 cents last Friday.
