Department Policy on Field Allocations

After School Allocations - Most Congested Time

Priorities:

- 1. School Game Fields
 - a. Allow SFUSD teams to have games close to their schools provided fields used efficiently
- 2. Shared Priority
 - a. School Team Practices (limited to one Middle School team and one High School team per School)
 - i. Received 2 practice slots per week
 - b. SFRPD Neighborhood Programs serving kids in neighborhoods
- 3. Other Programs and Teams
 - a. Focus on providing space to groups serving neighborhood kids
 - b. Balance: Some neighborhoods don't have any or have relatively few fields
 - c. Two Practices per week: Limited to older teams and teams developing for high level of competitive play

Weekend and Weekday Evening Allocations

- All requests were looked at together to ensure efficient use of fields
- Open play time set in advance
- · One game per week for every 2 teams.
 - Byes request will result in few games
 - Exception: If overall number of games across all teams in a league do not result in more than one game for every 2 teams
- No rainout make ups
- Permitted time balanced between adults and kids and different sports
- Approved Public Benefit programs receive priority
 - Demonstrating serve SF Residents

Youth Leagues and Practices (no permit fee)

- All games on weekends except for youth baseball twilight games
- All practices on weekdays subject to limitations above. Hours are 3:30 to 6:30 (extended to 7 pm at sites with school games 3:30 to 5:30-amended Sept 2010 by staff policy change)
- Designated practice times based on age

New Programs and Leagues

- New programs can only be considered if both conditions are met:
 - 1. They serve a need not served by other programs

- Example: If someone wanted to start a new adult women's soccer league, that would not be considered as we have one
- Example: Offer a flag football program new
- Example: Girls softball we are trying to grow this
- 2. Adequate space or we can cut another program
 - Generally there is only space at off times (Mon/Fri evenings) or off Locations (usually fields in poor condition)

Travel Soccer Teams

- Subject to separate limitations due to imbalance in scheduling
- · Continued modification
