### DUES HAVE BEEN INCREASED TO \$195 AS OF MARCH 1, 2023.

#### GENERAL REMINDERS/ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- We are excited to bring back the Spring walk through this year! All homeowners are welcome to attend May 7<sup>th</sup> at 3:00pm. We will be meeting in the visitor parking lot. We love pets in this community but please leave them at home if you plan on attending. See you there!
- With spring cleaning happening, please remember that all items being thrown away must **fully** fit in the dumpster. No items are to be left in the area around the dumpster. Items being given away must be taken to goodwill or arc or listed on places like Facebook marketplace. No items are allowed to be left outside even if they say free. Fines will be enforced.

#### PARKING REMINDERS:

- Every homeowner is only entitled to 2 exterior vehicle spots. No more than 2 vehicles should be parked in front of your unit at any given time. Inside the garage does not count as a one of these spots.
- Each homeowner is responsible for their guest's parking. Please ensure they are parking in visitor spots. Homeowners have the right to tow vehicles parked in their spots.
- If a guest is planning on staying more than 4 hours in a guest spot, please let a board member know.
- Please do not park, or let a visitor park, in front of the dumpster. Waste Management will not pick up our trash and we will be fined. Fines and/or towing will be enforced for those in violation.

#### PET REMINDERS:

- Please be sure to always leash your dog when in public areas. The city of Arvada requires leashes. Please help keep everyone, including your pup, safe by leashing them. Fines of \$50 will be enforced on those who fail to do so.

# Monthly Dues

Dues are \$195.00 per month, due by the first of the month.

Dues **MUST** be mailed. Please do not hand deliver to anyone on the board.

Many people have asked if dues can be paid electronically. Online Bill Pay lets you make recurring electronic payments. Your bank or credit union will mail a check directly to the HOA. If your bank offers this, add Woody Creek Townhome Association #1 as an individual biller, add payment amount, and the HOA address. Please note, the HOA will not be releasing any bank account information for this process.

If you are having trouble paying on time or are behind on your monthly dues, please contact the Treasurer at [treasurer@woodycreektownhome.com](mailto:treasurer@woodycreektownhome.com) to set up a reasonable payment plan. Payment plans must be submitted in writing and approved by the board.

While the HOA is passionate about the community, the board members are not landlords nor law enforcement. The board has set responsibilities and will **NOT** interfere with personal matters that are outside those set responsibilities. As homeowners ourselves, we ask that these matters that are outside the realm of those responsibilities, are handled by you, the homeowner. Thank you.

## TRASH:

- Pick up days are Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Trash is not picked up on holidays.
- WE ARE CHARGED FOR OVERFILLED DUMPSTERS AND TRASH ON THE GROUND - Help us avoid these fees. If you notice a dumpster is overflowing, please find a less-full dumpster or wait until trash is next picked up. Please place trash entirely in the dumpster and clean up anything you drop.
- Visitors do not have dumping privileges. Please ensure your guests are not dumping their trash in our receptacles.
- Fines will be enforced for those who leave trash in areas that impede the use of the dumpster for other homeowners.
