The big news with the pantry this month is the introduction of a new software program from the Eastern Illinois Food bank (EIF). This new program allows more information to be entered for each member of the households served.

Basis information such as age, gender, and relationship to the head of household is obtained, along with employment status, and whether or not a member is a veteran.

This information serves to get a bigger picture of the type of guest using food pantries, and how better to serve them. Another benefit is that once a guest has been entered into this new program they will show up at all food pantries served by the EIF.

As with any change, there is also a down side. Entering all this information is time consuming, which causes a delay during distribution times. Fortunately, guest have been patient as this process goes on.

This also requires training for the front desk intake volunteers, which is also time consuming. However, once all current guest information is entered the process will go much quicker. At least that is the plan!

Just as a reminder, all work done at the pantry is by volunteers, which allows the pantry to use all the monetary resources to be used for the purchase of supplies for guest distribution.
