Reports

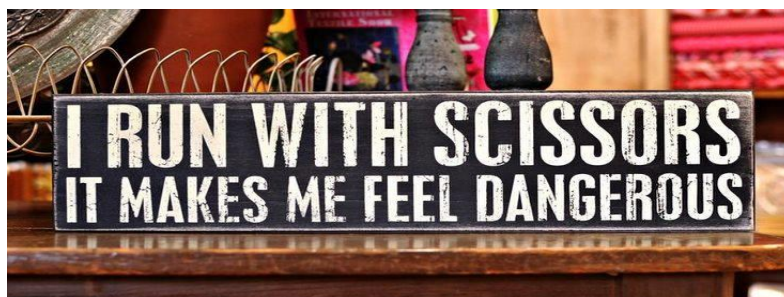
- Jan brought a Bluetooth speaker in and demonstrated how it would work by talking through her phone via Bluetooth. There is an annoying delay, but it is a free phone ap. We could probably do something for under \$100, and the steering committee thinks we should do it. Jan will get exact figures.
- We talked again about the web site. Mary Lee Cooper has been working on this, getting advice from her son and talking to GoDaddy -- we need to invest some money to upgrade the web site. We are looking for quotes to build the site. There may be someone in the guild who can advise us.

Quilting on the Bayfront Bus Trip

So, fellow quilters, I know it’s in the future, but try to commit, and if you can’t go after paying, we’ll try to find another person to take your spot.
