

Learn, Play, Have Fun with Chess at Callingwood Recreation Centre

2nd floor, 17740 69 Avenue (stairs at west end of building)

Saturdays: 9 to 10 a.m. Beginners / 10 to 11:30 a.m. Experienced & Older Students

- New students welcomed to join this class but priority given to repeat students.
- Grades 1 and 2 students may join if mature enough to work within class setting.
- New and younger students should attend the 9 a.m. class; experienced players attend the 10:15 a.m. class. (Repeat students attend the same class as in the spring, but you could be switched according to your skill level and level of players in each class. Instructors will determine placement after first class.)
- These Fall classes replace classes operating at the Roving ChessNuts facility in the northeast.
- Students keen about chess and also enrolled in a Roving ChessNuts school program can benefit with twice weekly lessons and play, can enroll with 15% discount.

Hundreds of Edmonton students are involved in chess learning at their schools or classes outside of their schools. *Join them in the fun!*

**Based on grade and skill of past and new students
instruction will be tailored to offer lessons/coaching to help all levels of players**

Each student receives a national Chess'n Math rating. There will be homework and study sheets provided. Our goal is to improve students' logical and strategic thinking skills, and improve their ability to focus and plan.

**To encourage students to challenge their developing chess skills and make chess friends from other schools,
any student entering their first tournament this fall will receive a \$10 entry fee discount**

One or more tournaments held each month, usually Sunday afternoons at Greenfield Hall, 3803 114 Street.
Tournament dates this fall are: September 23, October 21, November 4, November 25 and December 9

Special Chess Events this school year include Chess with the Oil Kings at Rogers Place on March 10, 2019

A school championship match for teams of 4 players will be held inside Rogers Place, plus individual round-robins, prior to team members and individual players watching an Oil Kings Games as part of their entry fee

Chess at Home is Encouraged

Roving ChessNuts encourage family chess and know from many years of instructing students, chess playing and practice at home can really advance skills and increase the educational benefits of chess which begin with the proper lessons.

Parents should make sure that an adequate chess set is available at home and there are exercises, support materials and occasional workshops available for families wishing to help their children, and also make chess a family fun activity.

Other notes regarding this Saturday morning program at Callingwood Rec Centre

1. A small snack will be served at the end of each class. *Usually somewhat healthy!*
2. Students who join late and have missed classes will be given a reduced fee and if a student has a prolonged absence and misses several classes, refunds or credit for the next session of classes can be given. (There are usually Fall, Winter and Spring sessions of classes if minimum number of students enroll.)
3. The e-mail provided will only be used for chess purposes to give parents access to class information, scholastic chess newsletters and chess event information.
4. Students will be required to sign a Code of Conduct and abide by its terms.
