Rachel jumped up. She put her  on. She frowned all the way to the  building.

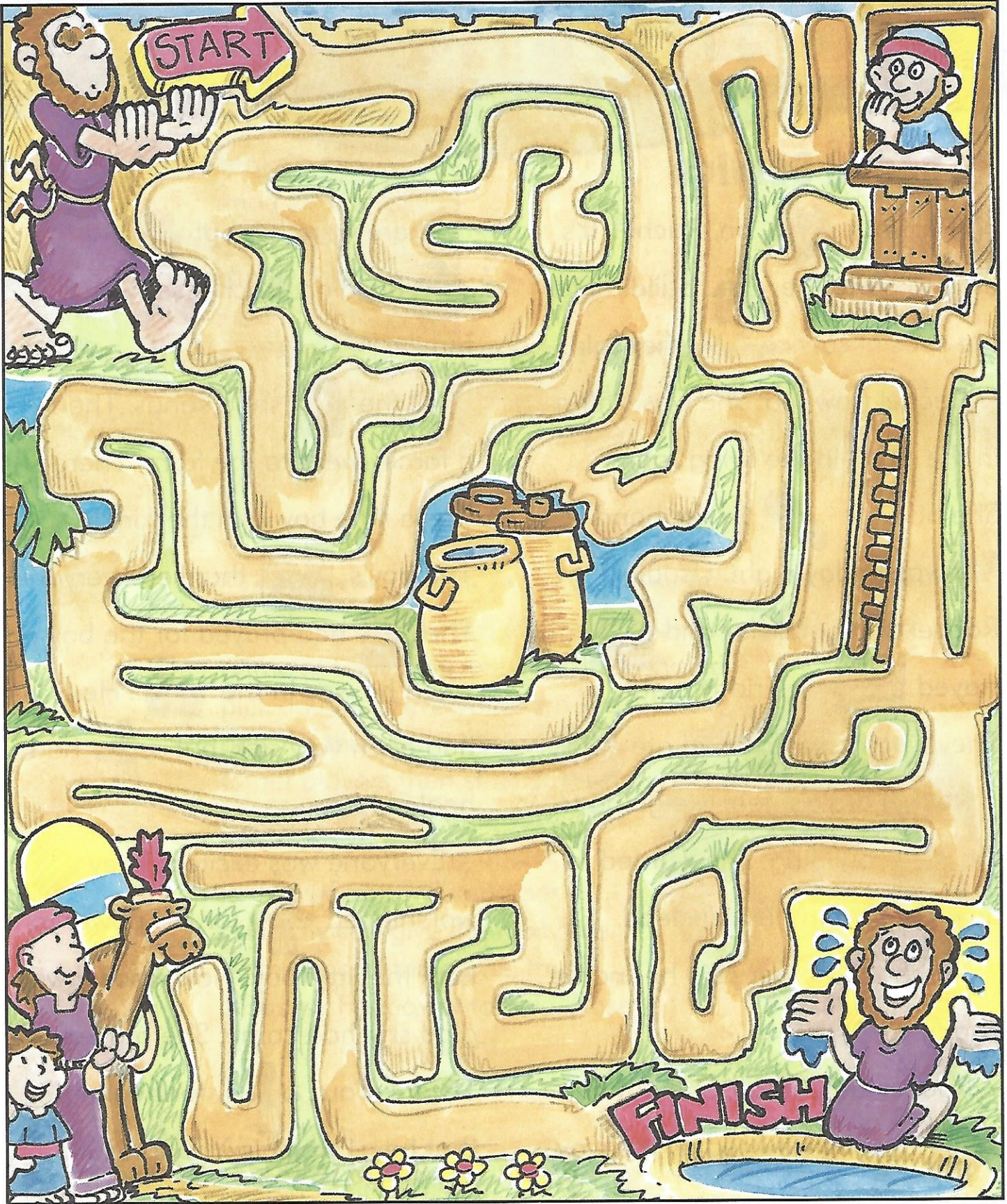

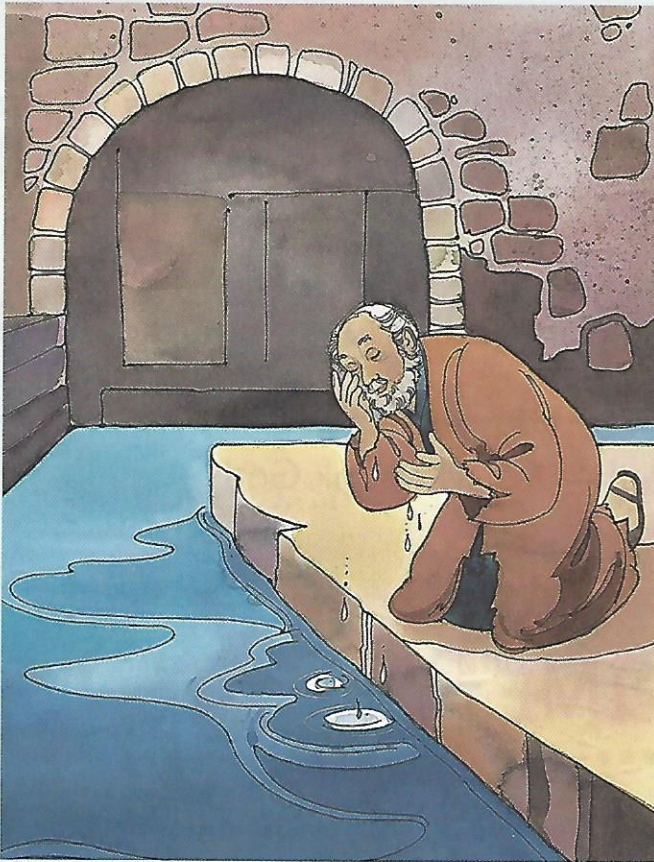

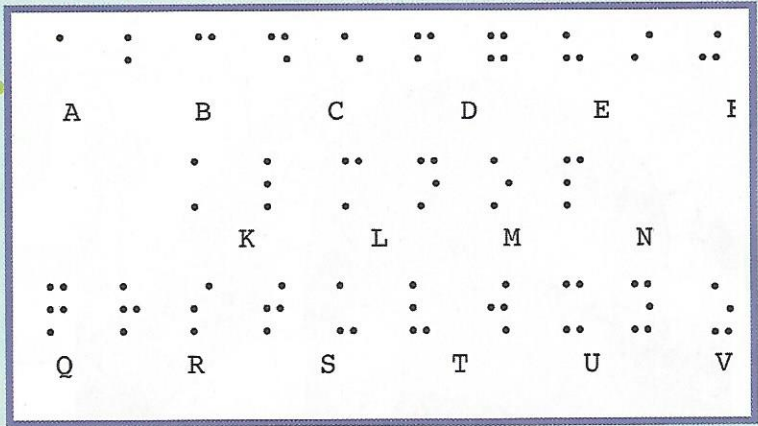

# FAMILY FUN ACTIVITIES

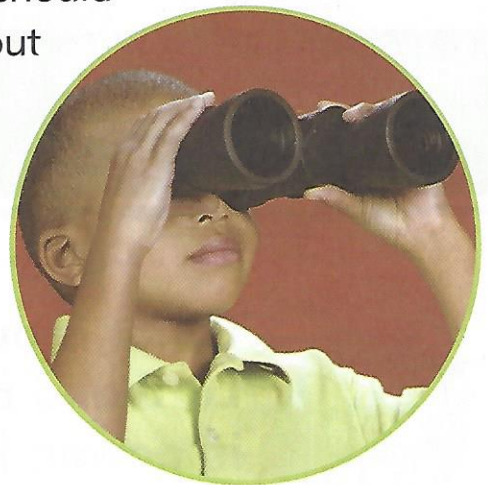
## FAMILY CREATIONS
